Ninth Air Force P-47D-30-RE 42-26136, from the 373rd Fighter Group, 410th Fighter Squadron (fuselage code R3-J), made a forced landing on Utah Beach on June 14. The pilot was returned to service immediately, thus no Missing Air Crew Report was filed. The Thunderbolt was stripped of usable parts and subsequently scrapped. NARA
