

How To Select an Arborist For Tree Services in Dublin?

When you are talking about healthy trees, there is a lot of work that goes into maintaining them. They need regular trimming and pruning in order to remain healthy. Trimming and pruning cannot be done just as per your wish. They have to be done in a way that the tree is not harmed in any way. Moreover, steps need to be taken in order to ensure that the trees are free from pests and diseases. All these can be possible only when you hire a company that is helmed by an Arborist in Dublin.

Arboriculturist is a person who is an expert in the care of the trees. He/she has the requisite knowledge about what the trees need and have undergone the requisite training for it. He/she is also properly equipped for taking proper care of the trees. You must remember that taking proper care of the tree is a good investment that gives you substantial returns in various forms. Thus you must always prefer to hire the Tree Service in Dublin with an arborist as they have the skills and expertise in tree care. You must always choose an Arboriculturist with great care and prefer to meet more than one so that you can get the best for your trees. To choose the right person you must:

Check for his/her credentials and certificates. The Arboriculturist must possess the ISA certificate and must be a member of TCIA and ASCA associations. This will ensure that the Arborist in Dublin is willing to learn and stay up-to-date with the latest techniques and information.

Check for the various licenses and permits. It is important that you check whether the licenses and the permits are valid and up-to-date. This will ensure that the service provider and the Arboriculturist are bona fide and you will not be duped. You must also check whether the Arboriculturist and the service provider have the necessary insurance coverage for all possibilities. This is important and will ensure that you would not have to pay from your pocket in case there is any damage to property or if anyone gets injured.

Check for the references that would show that the Tree Service in Dublin provider knows its work and has got experience in the type of work you would like to get done on your property. You must also not hesitate to cross-check the references and ask for their experience with the provider. If possible you can even visit the sites where the provider has worked.

Try to get more than one estimate if you are trying for the first time or are not happy with the previous service provider or the Arborist in Dublin. The estimates will give you an idea about the approximate expenses and the time it would take to finish your project. You must never go immediately for the lowest bid without checking all the credentials and specifications.

Key Services That Increase The Cost Of Tree Removal In Dublin

Trees form an integral part of not only your property, but also your life. But when the tree poses risk to the property or the passersby and the risk cannot be contained, and then it is time for Tree Removal in Dublin.

When you want to remove your tree, it is always better to hire a professional Tree Removal service in Dublin that has an arborist on its roll. You must ask the service provider for its licenses and insurance. You must check whether the insurance coverage is up-to-date so that if there is any damage, the liability does not come on you. You must also ask about the time they would take for the work to be completed. If you need stump removal, they might charge extra, so let them know in advance. You must not forget about the cleanup plan during and after the removal of the tree. You must definitely ask for the estimate from the tree service provider. The estimate should be in detail and after inspecting the tree to be removed and there should be no hidden charges. Hence, you must have an idea about the cost of removing the tree and what are the factors that affect it. Broadly speaking the estimated cost depends on:

Size of the tree: One of the most critical factors deciding the cost of Tree Removal in Dublin is the total height of the tree.

Condition: As it is easier to remove a dead and rotting tree rather than a strong and healthy tree, the removal of the dead or rotting tree will be cheaper. You must also make sure that if the tree is diseased, to mention it so that you can get a lower estimate.

Diameter: The diameter of the tree also plays a very important role in deciding the cost of removing the tree. You usually tend to pay more for a shorter but thicker tree than for a taller but slimmer tree.

Location: The location of the tree also plays a vital role in deciding the cost of Tree Removal in Dublin. If the tree is easily accessible and has few obstacles, then it would be cheaper as compared to a tree that is not easily accessible and is surrounded by utility lines and other properties as its liability goes up exponentially.

Increase in cost of tree removal

There are many other services that would increase the cost of the removing the tree.

- **Stump removal:** You must always remember that the stump removal is never included in the estimate of removing the tree. You will always have to more to get the stump removed as it requires different equipment for removing it.
- **Limb chipping:** If you opt for getting the limbs chipped instead of chopped then you will have to pay extra.
- **Tree trunk removal:** If you want the tree service provider to haul the tree trunk away, then you may have to pay more.
- **Log splitting:** If you are ready to pay more, then the Tree Removal service in Dublin provider can split the logs for your fireplace.

Now that you know what the basic and the extra services would cost you, you can always make an informed decision.

Major Reasons To Hire Tree Trimming Service In Dublin

The trees form a great part of our surroundings, environment and our lives. They not only enhance the beauty of the landscapes but also provide shade during the hot summers. To keep them glowing and healthy, you need to work for their upkeep and maintenance. Tree pruning and Tree Trimming in Dublin play a major role in keeping the trees healthy and disease free. There are various reasons for keeping the trees trimmed, some of which are:

- Reduce the height of the trees especially if they are posing problems to the utility lines.
- Remove the damaged branches or trim the branches that may be dangerous to the passerby or the property.
- To give shape and uniform appearance to the tree.

Though many people get confused between Tree Trimming in Dublin and pruning the trees and use the terms loosely, there is a difference between them.

Trimming: When you are speaking of trimming, you are speaking in terms of grooming the tree or maintaining the outer appearance of the tree. In it, you are just shaping the tree, so that the tree looks better.

Pruning: On the other hand pruning deals with the overall health of the tree. In it, you remove the branches or the limbs of the tree that are dead or diseased. You also take care that when cutting the major branches, you do not cause major stress to the tree.

Though it may seem that Tree Trimming in Dublin is a very easy job, in reality it is not. You require professionals from the tree services to do the job. This is because they understand all about tree care and have the right tools and equipment to do it. This will help not injure the trees during the trimming process. Some of the important points you must remember during the Tree Trimming in Dublin are:

- You must always prefer to trim the branches that have narrow angles and are weak. You must prefer to avoid those branches that have a U-shape and are strong.
- You must prefer to remove the branches when they are young as it is easier to handle them and also the process does not leave any scar behind.
- You must not allow the use of spurs or spikes to climb the trees as these cause injuries to the trees.
- You must have the knowledge about the branch collar and avoid removing it. You must not trim the branches too close or keep them too long.
- You must always look for and identify the branch collar which grows from the tissue of the stem. It can always be found at the base of the said branch.
- You must make sure that you do not injure the branch collar so that the tree is not harmed and it remains healthy. You must cut the branch from outside its ridge and away from its stem.

The cost of Tree Trimming in Dublin depends on a variety of factors such as the size of the tree, its location and accessibility and health of the tree.

Techniques Used by Tree Pruning Professionals in Dublin

When you are growing trees on your property, it is essential that they look groomed and healthy. A groomed and healthy tree enhances the beauty of your property and the landscape. It also increases the life of the tree while removing the chances of it causing any damage to the property or injuries to the people. There are basically two ways of maintaining and grooming the tree- the trimming and Tree Pruning in Dublin. The trees are usually pruned for:

- **Aesthetics:** When you prune a tree, you are helping it to maintain its appearance and shape. At the same time, you must never try to impose an unnatural size or shape on the tree. The tree can get seriously damaged if you do not prune it properly.
- **Safety:** One of the biggest safety hazards of any tree is when the tree's broken or dead branches or limbs fall off anytime. It can also be hazardous if its lower branches cause obstruction to your vision especially during driving. Another source of hazard is when the limbs or branches of the tree grow very close to the utility lines.
- **Health:** An infected tree can be saved if it undergoes judicious Tree Pruning in Dublin and the affected branches and the limbs are pruned off. Thinning the crown of the tree is beneficial as it improves the airflow.

When to prune

You can routinely prune the tree to remove its weak and diseased or the dead limbs and branches any time during the whole year without adversely affecting the health of the tree. On the other hand, the basic rule of Tree Pruning in Dublin is that the growth and wound healing of the tree take place and is maximized if it is pruned before the spring growth spurt.

Prune techniques

- **Crown thinning:** When thinning the crown of the tree, you must keep the lateral branches evenly spaced. You must also prune away the branches that run against the other branches or cross them. At no time must you remove more than one-fourth of the living crown of the tree.
- **Raising Crown:** You can raise the crown of the tree by Tree Pruning in Dublin by pruning the the lower branches of the tree but at the same time, you must maintain atleast two-thirds of the tree's height.
- **Crown reduction:** You must always prefer to remove only the secondary whole branches if you want to prune more than half of the tree's foliage. The reduction also helps in maintain the form as well as the structural integrity of the tree.

How much to prune

The size of the tree, its species, age and the reason for Tree Pruning in Dublin decides the amount of the tree tissue that can be removed. As a rule, not more than the 25% of the tree crown can be removed at one time in young trees and it is less for the mature trees.
