# MATCH REPORT

HIBERNIAN **5**  
INVERNESS CT **2**



28.02.20 | EASTER ROAD, EDINBURGH  
WILLIAM HILL SCOTTISH CUP

Hibernian progressed to the Semi-Final of the Scottish Cup as they beat Inverness 5-2 at Easter Road.

John Robertson made four changes to the side which beat Dunfermline 2-1 at East End Park as James Keatings, Tom Walsh, Kevin McHattie and Charlie Trafford came into the side for Roddy MacGregor, Miles Storey, Lewis Toshney (cup-tied) and James Vincent.

Caley Thistle were looking for their second Premiership scalp after beating Livingston in the Fifth Round and were close to taking the lead in the opening minute as Tom Walsh's cross found Jordan White in the middle but his header was straight at Hibs keeper Marciano.

After 7 minutes, Martin Boyle was booked for simulation after being played clean through on goal by Scott Allan and the winger went down under the challenge of Mark Ridgers.

Caley Thistle continued to look threatening and Tom Walsh saw his effort go across the box after a good move from Caley Thistle involving the winger, White and Keatings after 17 minutes.

Just before the half-hour mark, Hibs were awarded a penalty kick. Kevin McHattie was judged to have pulled McNulty down in the box and Nick Walsh pointed to the spot.

Hibs captain Paul Hanlon stepped up to take the penalty but he was denied by a superb save from Mark Ridgers and the rebound came back to Hanlon and Ridgers again tipped it over.

Tom Walsh was then inches away from opening the scoring for Caley Thistle as he raced clear and go a shot away from just inside the box but saw his effort hit the inside of the post.

Hibs did have the lead after 38 minutes, Stevenson's deep free-kick was flicked on by Doidge into the path of Adam Jackson in the box and the Hibs defender turned it in from close range to opening the scoring.

In the second-half, Inverness started brightly again as Walsh forced a save from Marciano after 49 minutes.

Scott Allan was found on the edge of the box by Martin Boyle but his shot was wide of the mark.

After 57 minutes, Allan did have his goal after he finished a quick counter attack from the home side. Hibs broke through Martn Boyle as he slipped the pass to Mark McNulty and he found Allan in the box to finish for 2-0 to the home side.

Inverness thought they should have had a penalty at the other end as Tremarco looked to be fouled in the box but nothing was given by the referee.

After 71 minutes it as 3-0 to Hibs, Paul McGinn found Rangers loanee Greg Docherty in the box and his shot was low and past Ridgers.

Inverness grabbed one back just a minute later, straight from the re-start Inverness work the ball well and it resulted in Charlie Trafford finding Carl Tremarco in the box and his shot deflected past Marciano to make it 3-1.

This proved to be an action packed period of the match and after 74 minutes, Brad Mckay was shown a straight red card by Nick Walsh after a late challenge on Christian Doidge. The resulting free-kick made its way to McNulty in the box but he was denied by a fine save from Mark Ridgers.

With just under ten minutes remaining, substitute Stephane Omeonga made it 4-1 to Hibs with the pick of the goals as he found the top corner as he unleashed a strike from around 25 yards.

Another substitute got in on the scoring for Hibs as Jamie Gullan drilled low past Ridgers from about 8 yards after 84 minutes.

Caley Thistle would be the last side on the scoresheet, late on in the match Tom Walsh saw his corner cushioned down by Shaun Rooney and Nikolay Todorov then finished the ball from close range for his 6th of the season.

**Caley Thistle striker Jordan White is looking forward to getting to the business end of the Ladbrokes Championship season, with the forward expecting a tight finish to the league but he said ensuring a second place finish is vital for the club's promotion chances.**

White said: "I think it is going to be a right good run in, we have a couple of games in hand but we want to get as far away from third and fourth as possible. We're concentrating on second place and that starts today."

He added: "We have the Challenge Cup final coming up as well so that's good to be involved in, there's loads to look forward to this season. We know from last season that you want to finish second to give yourself the best opportunity in the play-offs, if you finish third or fourth it does make it a lot tougher to try and get promoted."

"If you can get a run going then because the matches are coming thick and fast it carries on so you have to take it from there."

Easter Road proved a step too far for Inverness in the Scottish Cup this season but White wants the team to put that behind them to focus on the upcoming league matches.

The Caley Thistle number nine said: "We've been on a decent run and there's still loads to play for, especially in the league. We've got to just be confident going into tonight's match."

“We’ve got to get over Friday’s game quickly, we have a lot of games coming up and if we suffer any set backs then we just have to get over it and look at the next game.

We’re confident ahead of tonight’s game and we will give it everything.”

“Against Hibs, I thought the first 60 minutes we gave a good account of ourselves, the goals we lost were disappointing. We hit the post and if a couple things had gone our way then it could’ve been a different story but at the end of the day they had good quality and punished us when we made mistakes.”

Today, Caley Thistle welcome Morton to the Caledonian Stadium and White expects a tough match this evening with Morton currently one of the form sides in the Championship.

White said: “Morton are doing well, I don’t think they have lost since the turn of the year in the league. It’s going to be tough, I know how David Hopkin sets his teams up as I’ve played under him so they’ll be hard to beat but we’re at home and want to be the dominant team.”

In the dying minutes of the match, Inverness won it. Brad McKay's long throw was flicked on by White into the path of Doran and the Irishman headed past Siegrist to send the Inverness bench and 700 strong support wild.

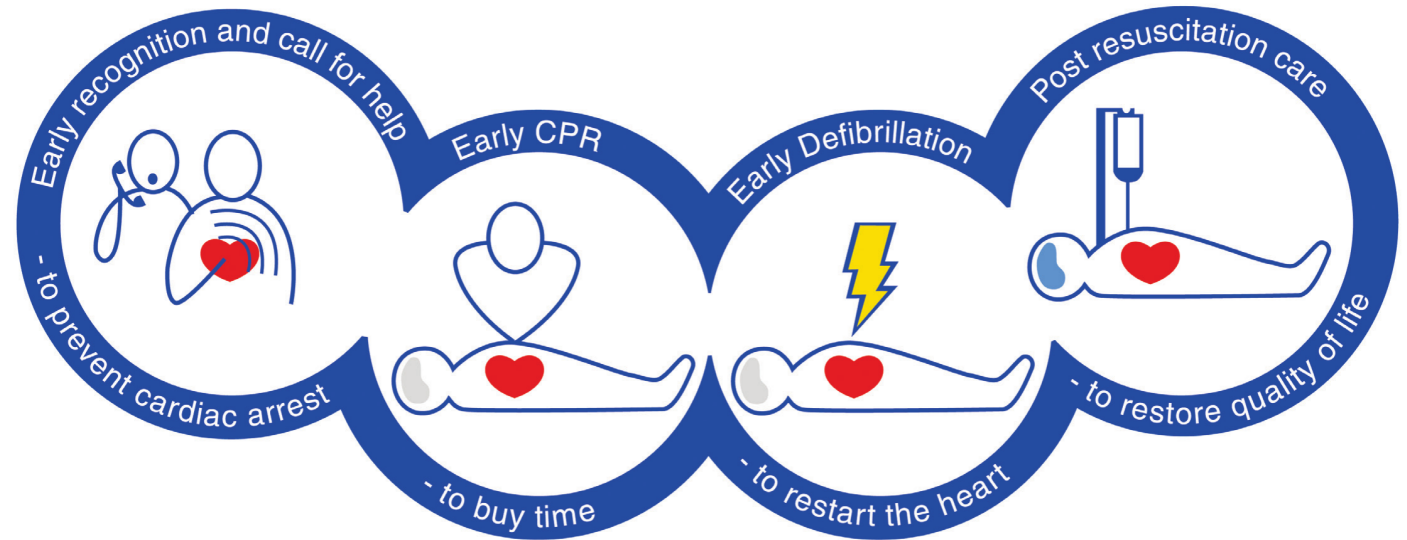

# ICTFC CODE OF CONDUCT

**Inverness Caledonian Thistle FC will not tolerate unacceptable conduct at the Caledonian Stadium or any away football stadia.**

**Unacceptable conduct is conduct which is deemed violent or disorderly.**

**Violent conduct is any actual, attempted or threatened physical violence against any person, or intentional damage to property.**

**Disorderly conduct includes:**

**Conduct which stirs up or sustains or is likely to or is designed to stir up or sustain hatred or ill will towards people or groups of people based on their membership of the following categories:**

- **Gender, Race, Nationality (including citizenship) or ethnic or national origin.**
- **Membership or presumed membership of a religious group or a social or cultural group with perceived religious affiliation.**
- **Sexual orientation**
- **Transgender Identity**
- **Disability**
- **Or against an individual who is perceived to be a part of such group**
- **Using threatening, abusive or insulting words or conduct**
- **Displaying or writing anything which is abusive or insulting**
- **Using words or conduct or displaying any writing or other thing which indicated the support or affiliation to, or the celebrating of, or opposition to an organisation or group proscribed in the terms of the terrorism act of 2000**

**All persons entering The Caledonian Stadium on a matchday are subject to these rules, including employees and volunteers of ICTFC whilst discharging their duties.**

**Any person who engages in unacceptable conduct will be liable for sanctions imposed by the club, which may involve possible criminal proceedings, ejection from the stadium, withdrawal of a season ticket and/or exclusion from future matches at the club.**
