Greet

Casually greeting potential entourage members and becoming familiar with one another.

It sounds like the easiest, but in actuality, this is the most challenging part of the guide. Why? Because a great entourage is full of cool and interesting people.

Unfortunately, most of the cool and interesting people have already formed groups and cliques of their own. And they have no excuse to hang around you, the guy that no one knows.

So, how do you get around this obstacle? You take the stragglers. You're not looking for the cool people, because they're already taken. Nor are you looking for the weirdoes that no one wants to be seen with. What you want to look for, are the normal people that simply didn't have time to become part of a clique for one or more reasons.

Every walk of life has these people, but I'll use college as the example. These are the categories of people that either are just now getting out of the military, didn't live on a college campus for their first year or two, started school late and feel too old to hang out with the freshmen, or were just really busy and didn't have much of a social life. In general you're targeting those that are of college age and haven't formed a clique, or those that went through college and have broken up with their old cliques.

They may not be cool yet, but they're normal. And if they're normal, then they have potential to be fun and cool. This requires that you take some kind of leadership role that will be explained in the next chapter, but for now, let's talk about how I went about creating the first members of my entourage.

If you've been keeping up on The Real Assanova blog, then you know that I spent a great deal of time in my dorm lobby on weekend nights. What was I doing? Talking to every single person that came through that entered and exited my dorm lobby at night, guy or girl. What this did, was get my name out there, made people really familiar with me.

I was doing two things. The first, since I was down there every weekend, is I caught eye of who did and didn't have many friends. I looked closely at those who didn't, screening for the normal ones that simply weren't part of a clique yet. And the second? I was letting them get really comfortable with me, so that when I invited them somewhere, I didn't come off as a complete stranger.

This doesn't have to just take place in a college dorm. It works anywhere. I've added people to my clique from smaller bars. These were those who would show up in ones or twos and didn't have time to get out much.

Sex Lips and The L from The Real Assanova blog were two of those characters, although I did end up getting romantic with Sex Lips after she jumped all over me. Before they met me, they had no kind of social life whatsoever. Sex Lips had a busy government position, and The L was in some kind of medical school.

Now, these aren't the only way to find normal people without a clique yet.

Dorms and small bars aren't your only source. You can find them in just about any organized group activity (such as social clubs). People usually join these groups in hope of making new friends, and I know that Misha and Zenfox have recruited from their local Hash Run social group.

The other source, when looking for women in particular, is online. If they're sitting at home, typing up an online dating profile, then chances are, they're lonely and looking for excitement. I've recruited from all of the above sources.

There are many other options, but in order to keep this guide at a reasonable length, I'll cover them in the future.

Most of you already know how to have a normal conversation with complete strangers, but if you're having trouble with this step, then I suggest taking one of our limited in-field <u>Rockstar Sessions</u>, where our certified Social Professionals will guide you every step of the way. For now, let's move on to the next chapter.

Recap:
*Greet people(guy or girl) in places you frequent often.
*These can be anywhere.
*Your dorm lobby, coffee shop, social group, park.
*Take note of the people you consistently see alone. Talk to them. A simple "How are you?" works.
*Become familiar with them, while letting them become familiar with you.
*The more frequently you talk to each other, the more comfortable you'll be come with one another.
*Distinguish which ones seem normal; Avoid the weird ones.

*These are those that probably aren't in an established social circle.

*Could have been too busy for an established social circle or clique.



Meet

Propose a small gathering. Small get-together at a local bar, your place, or event. Your entourage begins here.

Now that you've selected a few normal people for your entourage, it's time to bring them together. This is where you need a little creativity, well, not actually. You simply need a minor event to unite all of them. This can be a small, casual party at your place, or a small gathering at a bar. Use your imagination and replace "bar" with your common interests. Since I was a college kid when I was developing this system, drinking was our common interest.

Assuming that you now have an idea in mind, it's time to exchange contact information and invite them to your event. If you've been patient, and let your target entourage member get familiar with you, then when you suggest hanging out, they should be all for it. This is when you exchange phone numbers and/or directions to your event.

In my case, it was a small party in my dorm room. My first party started out with five people that included myself. Three guys, and two girls. This is where you have to set the tone.

They will only have a good time, if you're having a good time. This is perhaps the most crucial step in becoming well respected and seen as the "go to" guy. If you're not trying to have fun, then they won't, and they probably won't show up to your future events. And remember, these people have no friends to really hang out with. You don't have to do a lot to impress them. In reality, they just want friends. They're perfectly fine if you're not the most awesome person in the world.

When I threw that party, although there was a small number of us, I made sure we had a blast. There were drinks being spilled, items being knocked over, and people puking. Again, I'm not going to cover the details, as they will be covered in the future. The point of this guide is to just cover the gist of it. In short, they had a really good time and continued to come over.

If you're making sure that they're having a good time every time they come out, then it's time to really make a name for yourself. Up next? The Big One. This is what will launch you into stardom, give you rockstar status.

Recap:

*If you followed the "Greet" step correctly, then your potential entourage member should be comfortable with you to meet up.

*They're bored and looking for friends.

*They have no reason to say "no".

*Plan a small event at your place, bar, or whatever your common interests are.
*Make sure they have a good time.
*If you're a good host, they'll want to meet up more frequently.
*Follow this step correctly, and you'll be ready to launch into rockstar status.

Party

Your major event in which your new friends will bring their friends now that they know you know how to have a good time. This will launch you into stardom.

You now have a small group of decent friends. Great. Now it's time to really go all out. Do this right, and you'll be launched into stardom, just as I was when I threw my first big party (not the previous small one). At the time, I still only had a small group of friends, and no experience throwing a party whatsoever. I had just moved out of the dorms into my apartment with one of my new friends.

That's when I started planning. I wanted to go all out. It was my biggest investment as a college kid. I did my research on what made a great college party, and went to work. I hyped it up, and told my small circle of friends to invite everyone that they knew.

Already proven myself as a good host and fun guy, and how much I was about to put into this party, my newly acquired friends had no problem inviting all of their friends. In turn, their friends invited their friends. I knew this thing was going to be big. I did everything right.

So what happened? The party was a blast. I made sure everyone was happy by making sure they were having a good time. This party had done so much for my name. Before this, I struggled to maintain a steady stream of sex without becoming involved in a serious relationship. Now? People wanted to come over all the time. I couldn't throw an outlandish party every weekend. So, how would I continue to impress them and perpetuate my name?

One thing that I want to point out, is that I wasn't actually benefiting on my name and getting that steady stream of sex just yet. During this entire time, I made sure I didn't make the mistake that so many pick-up artists make. I DIDN'T HIT ON THE WOMEN I MET. I simply showed them a good time, and left it at that. These women would later become part of my entourage, as a result.

But like I was asking myself, how would I maintain the momentum that I had created? By investing in my own party kit, of course.

*If you followed the "Meet" step correctly, then your newly acquired friends will have no problem inviting their friends to your big event or party.

*Plan perfectly, do your research on what makes a big party good. If you need assistance with planning a party or huge event, the Rockstar Famous crew can help you. They all have successful track records with party development and promotion.

*DO NOT HIT ON THE WOMEN YOU MEET. Many "pick-up artists" make this mistake and get stuck having to work very hard to attract the occasional woman.

*Great party? Now you have a proven track record and everyone'll want to meet you.

^{*}Your name is out there. Good. Now it's time to keep it out there.



Fun

The party kit. Unique items in your home that will give people a reason to continue to come see you.

The Party Kit? What is it? Really, it depends on the interests of your group. But for me, my group consisted of hardcore partiers. I already had a decent TV and stereo system, but I needed a party kit. What could I buy, or create, or combine, that was difficult to find all in one place elsewhere?

That's when I came up with a solution. My apartment could hold a lot of people, so what did I do with it? I turned my room into a chill loungey type area. In the kitchen, was a beerpong/flip-cup table. And in my living room? Plenty of seating and older videogame systems. For some unexplained reason, women loved Mario Kart 64, and the guys loved beating each others asses in Street Fighter 2 and Mortal Kombat 3.

But I needed more. What makes all of that better, especially in college? Alcohol, and lots of it. Not only did I invest in a small bar mixing kit, but I budgeted a small portion of my income on maintaining alcohol. It was cheap beer and liquor, but it was still alcohol, and I made sure I always had it.

Again, not everyone has to drink. It was just relative to my social group at the time. Alcohol can easily be replaced with coffee, tea, a hookah, or whatever it is that your social circle does.

This was crucial for pre and after-parties. As of right now, I'm about to move into Misha's, and we're about to invest in a couple of big ticket items. Most namely a pool table and hot tub. This(the party kit) is going to keep a constant supply of women coming over to your place. Why? Because there aren't very many guys out there who can offer the same thing because they're being cheap asses.

Use your head. You can continue to waste money on World of Warcraft and other items that don't matter to women. Or you can invest in something that at-

tracts women and other cool guys. And it doesn't have to be something as expensive as a pool table or hot tub. Remember, I did this on a budget while in college. The only difference now, is that I'm able to afford nicer items.

At this point, word of mouth is going to work in your favor. Your once small entourage is now bigger, and they're going to start spreading the word about how cool you and your place are.

This is when I started to have women, and guys, bring other women to me. they'd say things like "I want you to meet my friend, Omari. He's so cool.", or I'd run into someone and they'd say "You're Omari, right? Such and such has told me so much about you!".

Now it was time to start benefiting. This is when women started to throw themselves at me. I was cool. My place was cool. And everyone loved me. This is when I started to sleep with women due to the status of my name alone. They wouldn't stop attacking me.

There's one instance where Hollywood and Vanilla busted in on me with a video camera, so maybe that video will pop up sometime in the future on the Rockstar Famous website. And there's another instance where I thought it would be funny to invite a bunch of women over. There had to be at least fifteen girls, and no guys. What now? It's time to take your entourage and hit the road. By now, you should be the center of your newly formed entourage, and as a cool guy, you should be getting invited everywhere. This is when you're really going to start to reap the benefits.

Recap:
*Invest in a party kit.
*A party kit is unique items, or a combination of items that are difficult to find elsewhere.
*A party kit gives people a reason to come see you. It will continue to perpetuate your name, creating a snowball effect of your status. The more people who come over and see how cool your place is, the more people will hear
about you and want to come over.
*Your name will become so well-known that women will start throwing them- selves at you, requiring very little use of game.
*Design your party kit around attracting women and sometimes cool guys who will bring you women.

*World of Warcraft is not one of those items.

*This step can take place before or after the "Fun" and "Women" steps.

*If you're at a bar talking to women, the party kit gives women a legit excuse to leave with you. I've used it over, and over, and over again.



Women

They'll come pouring in, but how do you select which ones to sleep with? Yes, <----that is my infamous five star Wal-Mart branded bed comforter.

If you've been paying attention, then you know that YOU DO NOT HIT ON THE WOMEN IN YOUR ENTOURAGE! Every pick-up artist makes this mistake, and as a result, the girl leaves immediately, or he sleeps with the girl, complicates everything, and she eventually leaves when she finds out that he doesn't want a relationship.

In most cases, she takes a huge portion of her friends with her. And you also lose some of the benefits. To give you an example, one of the first four people in my entourage happened to be a really nice OSU hockey player. She had a HUGE social circle, but she was always busy and unable to go out with them. She happened to live close-by, so we talked every now and then.

One day, after she was familiar with us, we invited her over for a very small party (five people). She had a blast, and as a result? Not only did she take me to sorority events, but she brought many of her friends to my house for my larger parties.

What happened? I was able to network with a plethora of her friends. And she made it easy for me by telling them how cool I was. As a result, I extended my social network drastically. She has to be responsible for at least half of my lays in college, whether directly or indirectly, and she doesn't even know it.

Had I hit on her right away, I never would have seen her again if I had failed to win her over. Or, in another scenario, had I slept with her in the future, she may have grown pissed off with me when she found out that I didn't want a relationship. In turn, she could have cut me out of a lot of her social events and network of friends.

This is why I'm strictly against hitting on or sleeping with my inner circle of females. They'll constantly bring new women and connections to me. The same

goes for the cool guys. They'll do all of my talking for me, and bring new cool guys or women to me. So, I avoid pissing them off when possible.

Who do you sleep with? You sleep with the women they bring to you. Even if you piss those women off, you'll still be cool with your inner circle, because you aren't doing anything to them directly. At the very worse, that woman that they brought to you won't come over anymore, but your inner circle will continue to hang around and bring new women to you.

And since you're the center of your social circle, the people they bring to you will think that you're cool, especially when your inner circle is telling them how cool you are. It further validates your coolness when you have the right party kit, and are able to throw a small party within an instants notice.

The above is how I was able to sleep with women without having to use any kind of real game. Visitors to my place would see how cool I was, and women would attack me, dragging me to my bedroom, or purposely asking to sleep in my bed with me. Why? Because women want to have sex with the cool guy.

It's no different than a woman wanting to sleep with a rockstar, even though she knows nothing about him.

This same principle applies when you hit the road with your entourage. The story with Delilah is a perfect example of this. When I brought my entourage to some of the bars I frequented, the woman I was casually talking to would notice how many people knew me, assume I was this really cool guy, and they'd be all over me.

A high value person in your social circle has the same effect. When I go to a bar, casually talk to a girl, and she sees me talking to the owner of a bar, or a bouncer who hits me with V.I.P. (this was the case with the Italian), she immediately places me in the rockstar category, and is all over me because I've displayed just how cool I really am.

As a result, she easily comes home with me (remember, the Italian actually invited me back to her place), and she starts hitting on and gaming me. In essence, I have reversed the game by becoming the prize. A lot of gurus talk

about becoming the prize, but how many have actually laid it out so that the average guy can understand it?

What Rockstar Famous has created, is a CONCRETE system for those who are tired of theory, after theory, after theory that only works for a very small percentage of the men out there. The Fame Game is by far, the <u>EASIEST WAY TO ATTRACT</u> WOMEN.

You can sit there in front of your computer, reading about the latest routine that other gurus have added to method's that simply don't work for the majority of men out there (keyword: majority), or you can take the path that so many of the cooler people that you aspire to become have. *DO NOT HIT ON WOMEN IN YOUR INNER CIRCLE!! (aka your entourage)

*You should have a HUGE entourage with you by now. It gets you noticed.

*Being the cool guy, you'll get invited everywhere.

*Being the cool guy and having an entourage will get you special perks at bars.

*Noticing that you're a big deal, people will want to be associated with you, thus bringing women to you.

*Women notice when you're a well-known guy (aka rockstar status), and pay attention to you.

*Women chase men of high status!

When I moved to German Village, I knew literally no one and had no friend's. I walked into Easy St. my first night and announced to everyone that my name is Mark, and this is now my bar. I hung out in Easy St. every fucking day until it seemed like everyone in the neighborhood knew who I was.

That's how I brought Jamie James into my social circle and she introduced me to lots of promoters, DJ's, and bar owners/managers. People ask me all the time when I'm going to try to fuck Jamie, but like you said, I've always knew that would be a big mistake, whether I succeeded or not. Sure, I'll flirt with her sometimes, but I've never made a serious effort to game her and have told other guys (some of my friends) to stay off of her as well. We might want to mention something about this to make it clear that you don't have to be in a dorm. You can use the same principles anywhere the same people gather regularly.

When I was thinking social game, I was going to suggest people find a coffee shop or a bar and grill in a cool area close to where they live, and hang out there until they start to meet people and build a social circle."

This is coming from a guy who has successfully rebuilt his social circle, and reaped the benefits of such. I won't go into details, but he lived a lavish life due to his connections and status. And when I say lavish, I'm talking about sleeping with strippers and porn stars, not because of his game, but because of his social status!

So what happened? He had a kid, and wanting to do the best for his son, he gave up his lavish lifestyle to focus on being a father. And then, he woke up one day, realized he was fat, old, and didn't have much of a social circle left. The life of dating strippers and hanging out with other high status males was over.

"1) One thing that comes to mind is I think you misattribute what causes your success. I think it's less opening direct or being sincere or whatever, and more that you're a funny asshole, which is pretty much synonymous with good attraction game. My favorite reports from you you mention a few things you say to the girl early on and I often laugh out loud while reading them.

- 2) Another thing that strikes me is that you seem to do a lot of takeaways. Sometimes I read the reports and I think "woah, why'd he leave that girl, it looks like she was into him" I guess that's one of those things that separates the good, the willingness to walk away really hooks them, and your reports definitely demonstrate that.
- 3) You do seem to game like most naturals, no routines, early C/F, and emphasis on ONSs over phone game. That's definitely cool, and a style of game I respect and plan to eventually get to.
- 4) Another thing is that you don't seem to do group theory much, which I would say is overrated in some cases, especially if you hook the target quick. I'm curious whether that's an accurate observation, and also whether you open mixed sets at all?
- 5) People say ONS is all logistics, but I can see that to a large extent, how much the girl is into you is far more important. You seem to pull in a lot of situations where the girl pretty much decides that she wants you and wants to get with you that night, regardless of the circumstances.
