Narrative rate can either be sped up or slowed down. Phraseological viewpoint concentrates on the speech attributes of characters and the narrator. Ideological perspective is not only "one of the most standard element of point of view" but also the "least available to formalization, for its analysis relies to a degree, on user-friendly understanding." This element of point of view concentrates on the standards, worths, beliefs, and Weltanschauung (worldview) of the storyteller or a character.

First-person [modify] A first-person perspective reveals the story through a freely self-referential and participating storyteller. First individual produces a close relationship between the storyteller and reader, by describing the viewpoint character with very first individual pronouns like I and me (as well as we and us, whenever the narrator becomes part of a larger group).

Frequently, the first-person narrator is the protagonist, whose inner thoughts are expressed to the audience, even if not to any of the other characters. A very first person storyteller with a limited point of view is unable to witness or understand all facets of any circumstance. Thus, a storyteller with this perspective will not have the ability to report the scenarios fully and will leave the reader with a subjective record of the plot details.
