Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



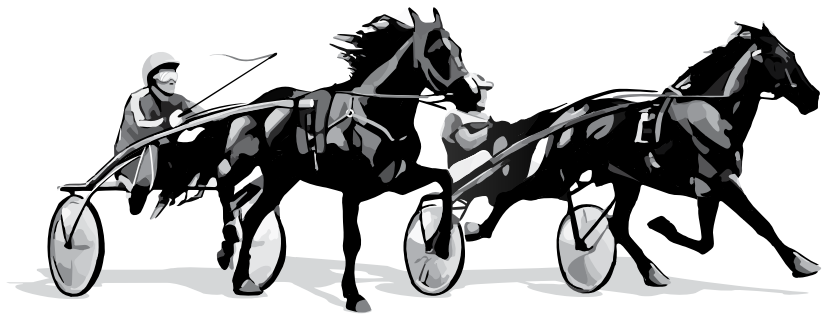
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

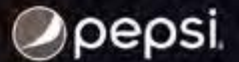

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#6 CELIA BAYAMA has hit the board in two of three as a sophomore and was third to Dabarndawgswatchin in NW2 in her most recent try. She went parked out a long way off the gate when she stayed on the outside to drive onto the lead at the three-eighths marker. This filly ended up fading to finish third in the stretch but held that position by a wide margin over the fourth-place finisher. She went four for 10 as a rookie last season and might find her best stride in this bottom condition event.

#5 ASKMYSECRETARY claimed the show spot at this level in her return to Mohawk Park on June 15th and followed it up with a runner-up effort over Georgian Downs. She had no chance in her latest when she got away ninth of the gate from the eight-hole and followed her rivals around the racetrack. This mare draws the center of the gate tonight and figures to be forwardly placed. She is one of the key chances in the race.

#8 DIXIE STAR N had no chance in her debut over the surface last week when she got away last off the gate from the 10-hole and was still more than 12 lengths off the lead at the three-quarter pole. She drops down a notch to the bottom condition class but does get much relief in the post position department by drawing the outermost post in the contest. This mare got past the one above last week when they finished within a length of each other under the wire. She should not be overlooked.

#2 NAUGHTY LADY B drops back down to this level after finishing third in the class above this last week. She was the runner-up in here on June 15th and has shown decent form so far in her nine-year-old season. This mare draws well and retains the services of Doug McNair.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 MARAUDER SEELSTER was a \$55,000 yearling purchase at the London Selected sale that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by Amanda Fine. This colt comes into this with two qualifiers under his belt and scored on the front-end on the morning of June 25th when he trotted in 2:01.4 with a final panel of 28.4. He appeared to be under-wraps to Roy under the wire with lots left in the tank. We will give him the edge in this rookie trotting affair.

#9 DULY RESOLVED was a \$30,000 yearling purchase that will be making the first start his career for trainer John Bax. He was a wire-to-wire winner in his most recent morning prep on June 25th when he held a comfortable margin throughout before scoring by two lengths in 2:00 flat. This son of Resolve came his back-half in 59.1 with a final quarter in 28.2. He gets an outside post for his debut but has shown enough early foot that he might be able to overcome it early.

#7 MARVIN HAGLER was a \$13,100 yearling purchase at the London Selected sale and will be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Mark MacQuarrie. He made a break in stride in his first qualifier on June 19th but then came back with a solid effort last week when he was the runner-up to our top choice. This son of Crazy was doing his best trotting in the shadow of the wire and was under tight lines to Filion.

#8 SOUTHWIND DOMINO is one of two in the field that already has a start under their belt. He got away third off the gate and then moved first-over around the final turn but was unable to get to a dominant winner in World At War Deo. That experience might help him tremendously tonight and he should not be discounted.

#5 BETTER DOUBLE FLIP is one of two fillies in the race with a start under their belt. She finished second to her stablemate in her lifetime debut on June 24th and might be able to use that experience to her advantage against this more inexperienced group.

He was a dominant winner in NW1 on June 15th and then had no chance in his follow-up try on June 22nd when he got away ninth off the gate from the seven-hole. This gelding came his back-half in 56.4 and his final panel in 28 seconds flat on his way to a fifth-place finish against a rock-solid group that included both Dealin With Dewey and Up And Ready. Taking a shot on this one in the hopes that he goes forward off the gate.

#4 RITSON returns to Mohawk Park after spending the early part of his sophomore season stateside. He broke his maiden in his latest effort at Harrah's Philly on June 23rd in what is the equivalent to the OSS Grassroots here in Ontario. He stopped the clock in 1:54.1 after sitting the two-hole throughout and trotting home in 27.2. The major concern with this Steacy pupil is the two breaks in stride in his last four and five miscues in his 13 lifetime starts overall. He picks up the soft hands of James MacDonald, who drove him to a third-place finisher in his first career start here last year.

#6 HP STARLETTE has been facing tougher in her last four tries in NW3 and should appreciate the class relief by getting into this NW2 event. She typically would not be eligible for this race, but the race office extended the win allowance for mares to be four instead of the usual three. This mare has banked over \$90,000 in her career and has been no worse than second in three of her last four at the level. She merits respect in here and has a winning chance.

#5 MAGIC WANDA has turned in a pair of decent efforts since racing has returned and was the runner-up in this class last week to an eye-catching performance by HP Running Mass. She just missed two back when she was beaten a half a length in third and has now hit the board in four of six this season. This mare can pick up another share this time around.

- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

HOW TO BET

Please call your bets to a teller in the following manner: Amount of base bet, type of bet, horse numbers.

Examples: \$3.00 to Win, number 7; \$5.00 Daily Doubles, 6 and 4, 7 and 5.

The minimum amount for a single bet in any pool other than Superfect, Pick 3 and Pick 4 is \$1.00.

TYPES OF BETS

The following types of bets may be made on each race:

WIN - You must select the winner of the race.

PLACE - Your horse must finish first, second.

SHOW - Your horse must finish first, second or third.

The following "feature" bets are available on one or more races as indicated in the program:

DAILY DOUBLE - Select the winner of two consecutive races for the races designated as the Daily Double events. This bet must be placed before the first race.

EXACTOR - Select the first two horses in exact order of finish.

TRIACTOR - Select the first three horses in exact order of finish.

SUPERFECTA - Select the first four horses in exact order of finish.

PICK 3 - Select the winner of three consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 3 events.

PICK 4 - Select the winners of four consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 4 events.

BOXES AND WHEELS

By "boxing" or "wheeling", you can combine several bets on one ticket, as follows:

DAILY DOUBLE

Wheel one "key" horse in the 1st race with several horses in the 2nd race or several horses in the 1st race with one horse in the second race - your ticket is cashable if the key horse and one of your choices in the other race are both winners.

Example \$1.00 Daily Double Wheel, number 3 "on top" with a nine horse field, cost is \$9.00 (9 combinations)

EXACTOR BOXES & WHEELS

Box two, three or more horses - your ticket is cashable if two of the boxed horses finish first and second.

Examples: \$2.00 Exactor Box, 3 and 5 - cost is \$4.00 (2 combinations)

\$3.00 Exactor Box, 2, 4, 6 - cost is \$18.00 (6 combinations)

\$1.00 Exactor Box, 1, 3, 5, 8 - cost is \$12.00 (12 combinations)

Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position, -- either first (on top) or second (on bottom).

Example: \$1.00 Exactor Wheel, 3 "on top" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$8.00.

TRIACTOR BOXES AND WHEELS

Box three, four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if three of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd and 3rd, in any order.

Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 5 - cost is \$6.00

\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00

\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$60.00

\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$120.00

SUPERFECTA BOXES AND WHEELS

Box four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if four of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in any order.

Examples: \$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00

\$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$120.00

\$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$360.00

Key Horse Bet also available - Example: \$1.00 Triactor Key, number 4 with numbers, 5, 6 and 9 - cost is \$6.00 (6 combinations). The ticket is cashable if number 4 (the "Key" horse) wins and two of the numbers, 5, 6 and 9 finish second and third.

Key horse plus 2 horses = 2 combinations;

Key horse plus 4 horses = 12 combinations;

Key horse plus 5 horses = 20 combinations; etc.

Wheel two horses to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if the two specified horses finished in the selected positions.

Example: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel 2 - 6 - "all" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$7.00 (7 combinations). Variations: all - 2 - 6, 2 - all - 6.

Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position:

Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel, 5 - all - all - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$56.00 (56 combinations).

\$2.00 Triactor Wheel, all - 8 - all - with an 8-horse field, cost is \$84.00 (42 combinations).

PARTIAL WHEELS

If you don't want to include all horses in a wheel bet, specify "Part Wheel" and call the horses's numbers individually.

Examples: \$1.00 Exactor Part Wheel, 7 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$4.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 7 wins and any of numbers 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes second.

\$2.00 Triactor Part Wheel, 3 with 8 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$8.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 3 wins and number 8 finishes second and any of numbers, 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes 3rd.

PLEASE NOTE

When calling **Box** or **Wheel** bets to a teller, specify the amount of the base bet - **for example:** \$1.00 Triactor Box, \$2.00 Exactor Wheel - and not the total cost of the wager.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
