OAON Marketplace REGULATIONS

One Africa! One Nation! UHURU FLEA MARKET RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXCLUDE ANY VENDOR THAT DOES NOT CARRY OUT THESE POLICIES:

VENDOR CHECK IN

- **Vendor check-In is from 7a- 9a OAON Registration Booth**
- **Vendors must check in by no later than 9am.**
- **If you have not checked in, contacted the flea coordinator and unloaded into your space by 9:30a, your space will be reassigned and you will not be refunded.**

Please have helpers or a dolly to unload your vehicle quickly and move your vehicle when double-parked. Event is open to the public 9am to 5pm. Vendors provide their own tables and displays.

SPACE ASSIGNMENTS: Space assignment numbers will be given at the registration check-in booth after 7 A.M. and volunteers will assist in escorting to the space. No generators are permitted. If you bring a tent to use in a large space, it cannot be larger than 10ft. X 10ft. Your tent & all your items **MUST FIT** within your 14ft. X 14ft. space. The 6ft. X 6ft spaces are not large enough for an 8ft. umbrella or any tent, you will be in your neighbor's space.**

ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING IN THE PARK, penalties are \$50.00 plus damages. (*payable to Phila Parks and Recreation Dept*).

UNLOADING: OAON Markets posts No Parking to allow vendors space to unload. Loading areas are limited to **Chester Ave SOUTH SIDE ONLY & on 43rd St. between Chester & Regent.** Unloading is on a first-come, first-serve basis. We ask vendors to use these spaces to UNLOAD ONLY. Please **unload all your items onto the sidewalk** quickly and then park your car, **before** setting up your space, so other vendors can unload. *There is NO double-parking Chester Ave due to trolleys.*

RAIN DATES: Rain Dates are Sunday, the following the initial market date.

(Please bring a tarp/plastic for a possible light rain)

****Call the One Africa! One Nation! Markets voicemail at 267-875-3532 after 5 am on the scheduled morning of the flea market to find out if a rain date has been called. We determine the decision at that time.****

CLEAN UP: Vendors are required to leave their spaces clean. To continue vending at this flea market, please bag your trash and place it in existing park garbage cans. Do not leave any large items, like furniture or lamps. It is important that we leave the park neat and clean so we can return.

FEES: This flea market is a project of the Black Star Industries & African People's Education & Defense Fund (APEDF), a nonprofit organization. All proceeds benefit APEDF programs for health, economic development & human rights for the black community. Fees: \$25 for 6'X6' space, \$45 for spaces 14'X14'. Food Vendors \$75. Only the Health Fest & Book Fair is \$100 for all Food Vendors.

PAYMENT METHOD: **One Africa! One Nation Markets accepts money orders or cash only.**

Payment and signed registration form must be received **TEN DAYS** before the flea date to guarantee your space, and you must be accepted verbally or by email during this process.

• Money-orders are payable to **One Africa! One Nation! Markets!**. Please put your name & 10 digit phone # on payment. We will call or email you to confirm receipt of registration if received early enough.

CANCELLATION POLICY: CANCELLATION DEADLINE. You must give seven days CANCELLATION NOTICE. Please call or email on Friday, a week before the flea market. Your fees will be refunded or moved to another month of your choice if we have vacancies. We will confirm your cancellation by phone/email. **IF YOU DO NOT CANCEL A WEEK IN ADVANCE** You will be marked as a NO SHOW and will not be entitled to a refund. If this occurs, your payment will be processed as a donation. There are no exceptions.

MAILING LISTS & LOST OR MISDIRECTED MAIL: One Africa! One Nation! Market is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Please inform us of any changes of address, duplicate mailing, name change, new email or phone number.

PRIVACY POLICY: OAON Markets will not rent, sell or share your information with third parties.

DAMAGE/LOSS: OAON Markets is not responsible for any damage and/or loss to property. Make sure that your space is secured.

ADVERTISING & MARKETING: OAON Markets advertises the flea markets in local & online newspapers, email lists, local and regional calendar announcements and Facebook, as well as flyer distribution.

VENDOR SALES: Vendors keep their individual sales. OAON Markets does not guarantee vendor sales.

ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE SOLD: We limit **new items** to a certain category & will discuss that individually with vendors.

NO SALES OF WEAPONS INCLUDING COLLECTIBLE WEAPONS: Includes, but not limited to guns, bullets, knives, slingshots, swords, pepper-spray, fireworks, flammable liquids etc.

NO DRUGS OR DRUG PARAPHERNALIA: Including, but not limited to, drugs, head shop items, pipes, bongs etc.

OTHER RESTRICTED ITEMS : Including, but not limited to, stolen merchandise, bootleg DVDs or CDs and similar items.

NO PORNOGRAPHIC MATERIALS : Including, but not limited to, literature, magazines, video, DVDs or similar items.

NO SOCIALLY OFFENSIVE ITEMS: Including Nazi or other white supremacist items, or other items deemed offensive by coordinators or shoppers.
