Port Augusta is resilient а community, overcoming challenges to forge its own future. It has undergone many changes over the years, including the recent transition from coal-fired power stations to renewable energy production. It has a strong future around a broad range of industries including tourism, the Sundrop large-scale greenhouse project, road and rail transport, and as a service centre for the region. Port Augusta City Council has invested in the City's growth

through infrastructure projects including a new Port Augusta airport terminal and the Central Oval complex which is used extensively for expos, seminars and sporting events. Port Augusta City Council is also environmentally conscious. Throughout the City, 'AridSmart TM' plants grown at the Australian Arid Lands Botanic Gardens are being used in parks, gardens and traffic corridors including the highway and Central Oval complex. These low-rainfall Australian plants use substantially less water than non-indigenous plants and are grown to thrive in the dry climate.


Through the re-use of water, Council sustainably waters its parks and gardens and has a continuous supply of water, even in times of imposed water restrictions. It has established itself as a leader in water re-use by increasing the water production of the Waste Water Treatment Plan and constructing a dam to store up to 75 mega litres of treated waste water which can be used in peak periods.

Port Augusta City Council is also supporting community educational opportunities through the Children's University Australia program, university research projects undertaken at the Australian Arid Lands Botanic Gardens and support Community Tertiary Education Centre due to commence in January 2020.

Port Augusta is a community supportive of new industry and business and welcomes all delegates to the Resource Industry Conference and Trade Expo 2018.
