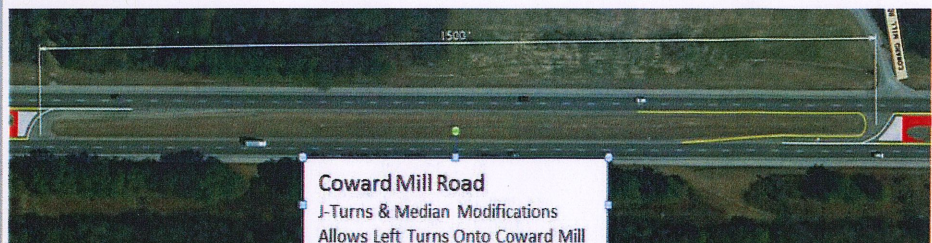

SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS & PROJECT INFORMATION

The Tennessee Department of Transportation will be making safety improvements on State Route 162, Pellissippi Parkway, in conjunction with a resurfacing project. State Route 162 will be resurfaced from State Route 62 to the Dutchtown Road Interchange. To improve safety along the corridor, TDOT crews will complete the following improvements:

- Centerpoint Boulevard - median removal
- Carmichael Road - median removal
- Schaeffer Road - median removal
- Coward Mill Road - median modification



FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS

- State Route 162 at Dutchtown Road Safety Project - tentatively scheduled for the Fall of 2018
- Hardin Valley Road Safety Project - tentatively scheduled for 2019
- State Route 162 at State Route 62 IMPROVE Act Project - tentatively scheduled for 2021
