



NOW OPEN in the Vestry (the room off the sanctuary).



So will the words that come out of my mouth not come back empty-handed.



THE PRAYER THAT JESUS TAUGHT (let us pray together)


Our Creator in Heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.
