



Ms. Tsvetelina Thompson is the voice of and an advocate for the victims of human trafficking, focusing primarily on women forced into sex slavery. Tsvetelina works both locally and internationally using her personal and tangible involvement with human trafficking. As a survivor of sex trafficking she utilizes her experience and knowledge to help law enforcement, civic organizations, and trafficking victims in the international fight against the human trafficking epidemic.

Tsvetelina is a naturalized Dutch subject of Bulgarian decent who first started helping sexually enslaved women in the world-famous Amsterdam Red Light District (De Wallen). While living in the Netherlands, she engaged closely with victimized girls, passionately supporting them in the struggle to restore their lives and independence.



Through her work, Tsvetelina has traveled internationally and lived in several countries. While in Europe, she facilitated the human trafficking training program for the Dutch Royal Gendarmerie. Tsvetelina was instrumental in providing instruction and exercises to the military police (*Koninklijke Marechaussee*) and the regional police (*Regiokorpsen*) on how to attend to the needs of enslaved victims of prostitution. She has worked closely with European and American television companies to create documentaries detailing the effects of human trafficking on the girls and society. Tsvetelina's knowledge and experience has armed numerous anti-trafficking organizations with the ability to establish prevention programs, look after victims' physical and mental health, and create other services the girls who have suffered the grim experience of sex trafficking require to restore their lives.

Tsvetelina relocated to the United States in 2015, where she is available as a consultant for local authorities and organizations. She frequents human trafficking conferences, where she is often a guest speaker. In 2019 Tsvetelina established her own non-profit organization, Twentyfour-Seven (501c3) which has developed a patent pending, method of delivering lifesaving information and services to victims of sex trafficking.

Twentyfour-Seven also:

- 🔥 Supports victims of human trafficking by providing them with psychological, physical, emotional and educational information.
- 🔥 Educates the populace and communities about the effects of human trafficking on society.
- 🔥 Helps communities and law enforcement with human trafficking prevention.
- 🔥 Raises awareness through civic events and social media.

Tsvetelina is a happily married mother of a mischievous little boy and has a beautiful golden retriever.
