At UCM, we are committed to providing you with plenty of options so you can earn your degree with little to no debt.

FINANCIAL AID

Federal financial aid can be used toward the cost of tuition, books or other living expenses so you can focus on obtaining your degree.

To qualify for the federal aid programs, including Perkins and Stafford loans and work-study, you'll need to:

- Be fully admitted into a graduate degree program.
- Enroll at least half-time (four or more graduate credit hours) each semester in courses that are applicable to the degree program.

The Perkins and Stafford loan programs provide low-interest loan assistance that usually does not have to be repaid until after graduation.

The federal work-study program provides assistance through part-time, on-campus or off-campus employment.

HOW TO APPLY TO UCM

Regular admission requires a bachelor's degree from UCM or another regionally accredited institution recognized by UCM.

To apply, all students are required to submit the following:

- ☐ 1. An application for admission at **ucmo.edu/gradapply**.
- ☐ 2. Official transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate coursework from all institutions attended.
- ☐ 3. \$30 nonrefundable application fee.

INTERNATIONAL GRADUATE ADMISSION

To apply as an international student, submit the following:

- ☐ 1. UCM international student application at **ucmo.edu/intlapply**.
- ☐ 2. Transcripts by uploading an unofficial copy to the student application portal. All transcripts must be translated into English.
- ☐ 3. \$75 application fee.

Before you can enroll, official transcripts must be submitted to the Graduate and International Student Services (GISS) office.
