

Minecraft Meets Omni Virtual Reality Rig, PC Game Gets New Launcher

Minecraft might not be the most thrilling experience but walking is all the Omni virtual reality device needs. Above two Omni developers take Minecraft multiplayer for a spin, demonstrating the high-voltage strolling, jogging and jumping that players can expect from the game in VR.

The Omni Kickstarter has a further 20 days left, and is currently at \$970,000 of its \$150,000 goal.

Minecraft is now available with a new launcher for PC, available for everyone without an Omni setup - and those who have one. The launcher's new version is required to play the game's most recent version, Minecraft 1.6 and any future updates. Although this new interface supports multiple usernames within an Mojang account (although that feature isn't yet enabled by Mojang) However, it allows for multiple usernames.

The new system will update automatically without the requirement to manually update. Single-player content will be available offline. Players must be online for this to be the case or the launcher will continue to try to reach the Minecraft servers.
