

1 Scenic Beauty & Moderate Climate

The picturesque Fraser Valley, in which Chilliwack is situated, has some of the most productive dairy farms in the world and is dotted with vegetable and blueberry farms. Beautiful glacier-fed lakes, streams and waterfalls, as well as, hiking, biking, and horseback riding trails are only minutes from any point in the community. Chilliwack is also the location of world-class salmon fishing in its rivers, 11 golf courses, 4 skating rinks, numerous tennis courts, white water rafting, and an endless array of other recreational opportunities. The Canadian National Kayak team uses Chilliwack as its year-round base. The nearest ski resort is a mere 1 hour away by car and Whistler-Blackcomb, the site of the 2010 Winter Olympics (where many of the school ski and snowboard clubs ski and board at) is just a 3 hour car ride away.

Chilliwack is just one hour by car east of metropolitan Vancouver, Canada's third largest city, as well as, just one hour away from the Pacific Ocean.
