

Minecraft Content Creator Technoblade has Died Following a Battle With Cancer

Minecraft streamer and creator of content Technoblade has died following an extended battle with stage 4 cancer. His family announced his death today in a statement to the public and a video.

Techno had previously disclosed that he had been diagnosed as having cancer in August. He has been updating his followers on a regular basis about his situation, while continuing to undergo treatment and creating content on YouTube.

Techno's father, Techno, narrates a final posthumous message titled "so long geeks" which was written to mark the occasion. It was filled to brim with the creator's signature dry and often dark humor, but also serves as one final 'thank you' to everyone who has supported the Minecraft star over the years.

"Thank you for your support of my content over the years. Technoblade would be my preferred choice in the event that I could live another 100 lives. Because those were the most happy years of my life," Techno said.

"I hope you enjoyed my writing and that it brought you joy. I hope you all live long prosperous, happy, and healthy lives. I love you all. Technoblade out."

In his message Techno who reveals that his real name is Alex, talks about how the proceeds from merchandise and other "sell-out" pushes in the last year are being used to send his children to college, if they want to go, along with thanking his audience for providing him with such joyous moments. All while slideshows of images showing him throughout various stages of his treatment are shown on the screen.

Following Techno's final message, his father explains the way he initially intended to write and record the video himself prior to his death, but his deteriorating health and other issues stopped the process from happening. His father claimed that he wrote the message while in his bed and passed away eight hours after.

"He was the most wonderful kid anyone could ever ask for," Technoblade's father said. "I really miss Technoblade. Thank you to everyone for everything."
