Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

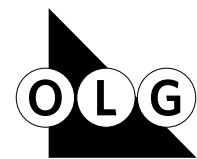
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 WHEELS ON FIRE was driven aggressively by McNair last time when he got away third and then moved to the lead before the halfway point. He set quick splits through three quarters and then was only hauled down by Nickel Bag, who sat an inside trip in the three-hole. He battled gamely in the stretch and fended off both the horse that was first-over and the pocket-sitter before succumbing to a rival who roared past them all late. Prior to his last two efforts in this class, he raced in the Preferred for 12 consecutive starts and picked up four wins in the process. He gets rail control tonight and if he can repeat his latest effort, he will be difficult to beat.

#6 BEST IN SHOW made his first start out of the Rob Fellows barn last week and finished third in here. He was moved first-over at the half and methodically advanced on the rim but was only able to get within a length of our top choice in the stretch. He has disappointed as the favorite for three consecutive starts but was off for three weeks going into his latest, so it is possible he might be better tonight getting back into a regular rotation. Using underneath.

#5 SPORTSLINE was used hard in making the lead from the nine-hole last time, tripping that station in 26.2, before releasing our top choice to the lead just before the half. He sat the two-hole and appeared to have pace in the stretch but was unable to advance up the cones with any authority. He ended up finishing fourth just behind the two horses above and can get a piece again tonight.

#3 HP NAPOLEON has been lights out in back-to-back victories and will move up in class again for the second consecutive week, after besting foes in both NW8000L5 and NW16000L5. This is a much stiffer test tonight, as he has never faced the likes of this class.

Filion moved her to the outside but was met by a wall of horses and he had to stickhandle for her to get up for third. This filly was locked and blocked for the entire stretch drive and had to settle for fourth, while running over top of rivals. She has upset potential and should offer a price.

Jamieson gave this mare an inside trip and she flew home in 25.3 when he showed her daylight in the stretch. She paced her mile in 1:49.2 and what was more impressive is the fact that it was her first pari-mutuel start in over a month after being scratched out of the Roses Are Red due to sickness. She might even be better tonight off that win, so we are giving this mare our top honors in what looks to be a competitive installment of the Milton.

#6 SO MUCH MORE was a fast closing second in her elimination last week and was only beaten a head on the wire. She went a similar trip the week before to be the runner-up in the F&M-Preferred and raced well to finish third in the Roses Are Red three starts back. She has been no worse than third in her last six starts and 16 of her 26 career wins have come over this surface. Expecting her to come up with a big effort tonight to land underneath.

#2 WARRAWEE UBEAUT looked like she was going to be an easy winner last week when she got wobbly late in the mile to get hauled down by out top choice. She took on the boys two starts back at Scioto Downs in an invitational event but only able to stick around for fifth. She was a lights out winner in the Roses Are Red here on August 29th and it would not be a shocking if she came back to that effort tonight. She and her connections have success when the chips are down, but we are using her underneath.

#3 ABUCKABETT HANOVER has won four in a row and is three for three at Mohawk Park. He cruised past his rivals in deep stretch three starts ago in the Nassagaweya and destroyed his competition in his division of the Champlain when he was won by seven lengths under-wraps. He was shut down at the wire in his elimination and paced his back-half in 54 seconds flat with a final split of 26.1. He starts from a favorable post position and should get all kinds of front-end respect when he makes the lead. He has been the easiest kind of winner in his starts leading up to this and we see him continuing that trend this evening.

#8 LAWLESS SHADOW sat the two-hole to our top choice in their elimination last week and this colt maintained his position in the stretch to finish second. He has been no worse than second in his last five starts and has only missed the board once in his rookie season when he made a break in stride on July 20th. He draws the eight-hole but was victorious from outside posts here in both an OSS Gold event and a division of the Nassagaweya. He possesses big early speed and McClure will likely have him flying off the gate to neutralize his difficult starting spot. He might end up being the pocket sitter again and is our main player underneath.

#6 NO BETTER JOY was searching for room in the stretch in his elimination and Roy managed to find him a lane late to get up for second. He paced home in 26.3 and was never given an opportunity to pace his best. He faded to fourth after moving first-over in a division of an OSS Gold two starts back but was a solid runner-up to our top choice in a division of the Nassagaweya on August 29th. Roy opts to drive the #10 Control Heaven, but MacDonald might be he perfect partner for this colt to get a softer trip.

#5 BAYFIELD BEACH was battle tested in the PASS and finished third in the championship event to Southwind Gendry. He was relegated to the three-hole last time and maintained his position behind our top choice. He paced his final quarter in 25.4 and should be in the mix.

#3 DONNA SOPRANO has been breathtaking in all five of her starts in her career so far and will now look to take the next step in taking on the boys, after beating some of the best fillies in North America in the Peaceful Way. There was some public debate over who should have gotten the spot between her and Macho Martini but after her most recent display of dominance against her own kind, she was the logical choice. She was shut down in the stretch and still won by more than four lengths in 1:53.3. This filly has never been fully extended and we will likely get to see what she is fully capable of in this race for more than a million dollars tonight. She is our clear top choice for Mohawk Million glory.

#10 VENERATE would be an intriguing option if he had not drawn the trialing post. This colt was lights out in the KYSS Championship last Sunday trotting his mile in 1:51.4, which is just one tick off Walner's world record. He comes into this race on just five days rest and would be more appealing if his nose was on the gate. He has improved significantly since that effort, but we do not see him getting the best of the filly above from the second-tier. Using underneath.

#7 ON A STREAK punched his golden ticket to this event when he surprised at 15-1 in the Wellwood Memorial by besting both Southwind Tyrion and his stablemate, Macho Martini. It was a gritty front-end score and the prior of those two rivals had the entire stretch to run him down. He figures to be pointed toward the lead again tonight and might be able to go a long way. He has a chance and should land on the ticket.

#9 INSTA GLAM had some success racing in the PASS and finished fourth in their championship final. Her dead heat win at the Meadowlands was certainly not her best effort but she gets back into a regular rotation and should be at her best tonight. She has enough speed to get spotted from the worst starting spot and should get a piece with the right trip.

#2 MATTICULOUS GB has four consecutive runner-up finishes in this class and has not crossed the wire worse than second in his last seven. He moved first-over against Century Farroh last week and chased that winner gamely to the wire to clearly be the best of the rest. He has not typically been the type of horse that takes a lot of air, as most of his miles in this class have seen him covered up in the two-hole. He picked up the services of Andrew McCarthy last week and retains him tonight. He draws his best starting post since the last time he tasted victory in the Preferred on August 1st. This gelding should be rolling for the lead off the gate and will likely cut it or end up in the pocket. There is no Century Farroh in here this time, and he should be tough to beat.

#6 ROCKME ROLLME has finished third in his last two Preferred tries and sandwiched in between those starts was an impressive 1:49.2 score in NW24500L5. This gelding has come into his own lately and has yet to miss the board when Jamieson is at the controls. He is versatile and has proven he can race from anywhere, especially in a field as compact as this. He figures to get a big piece of it and will be our main player underneath.

#5 CASIMIR RICHIE P finished second to the one above two weeks ago in a higher condition class. He sat the two-hole and maintained his position in the stretch but was soundly beaten by more than two lengths. He returned from out east with a win in NW17000L5 on September 4th after getting a brutalizing trip in the Gold Cup & Saucer and is not out place in this softer installment of this race. He was third or better in four of his last five efforts in the class and can hit the ticket.

#3 NICKLE BAG flew home in 26.2 for the win in NW22000L5 last week but now moves up to take on toughest class on the circuit. If he sits an inside trip, Macdonald might be able to get him to roll enough late to pick up a small share.

He was driven hard to the lead just before the half and kept on trucking on the front-end to win comfortably in 1:50.1. You will not find many front-end trips on his card and we are hoping that Roy has unlocked something new in this five-year old. He raced well to be fifth the last time he was in this class and had to close from tenth in the stretch after getting away last off the gate. He came his last half in 54 seconds and paced home in 27 seconds flat. He gets our top billing in a difficult race to navigate.

#10 NOCTURNAL BLUECHIP has not picked up a cheque since coming back from brief layoff following a vet scratch due to sickness on June 20th. He has been racing against much tougher and has been hampered with outside draws in his last two. This gelding plunges down multiple levels tonight to a class where he claimed victory last winter. He starts from the trailing post but has speed to follow. Andrew McCarthy picks up the drive tonight and this 22-time winner has his best chance in a long time.

#5 REAL WILLEY got away seventh off the gate in here last week and made nice late gains to finish third, only beaten a length on the wire. He came his back-half in 54.2 and his final quarter in 26.3. It was the first time in a long while that Filion drove this gelding and he is back in the bike tonight. We like his chances of hitting the ticket again.

#11 ROCKIN N TALKIN is the other starter from the second-tier and he raced decent last week to finish fourth in this class. He found a seam late upon diving to the inside and appeared to not fire up the cones, but he was pacing home in 26.4. McClure might opt to utilize the tactics he deployed with this gelding on August 29th where he circled most of the field to finish second in a mandatory payout race. He can get a piece.

#7 SIR PUGSLEY drops down a couple of notches on the class ladder and should be making noise late in the mile. He was a winner in here on August 8th, but a lesser share is expected tonight.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3, PICK 4 AND PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 3, Pick 4 and Pick 5 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three, four or five successive races specified for the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3, Pick 4 and Pick 5 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
