In what is probably the best build of the moment, LeshaNight took to Reddit to showcase a stunning image of a shattered floating city that is part of a larger project called Elden World. Elden World is a map that is built on the Elden Ring. It will eventually have more than twenty dungeons, castles special bosses, and powerful enemies to take on. This map will also recreate the stunning and treacherous Lands Between.

PlanetMinecraft says that the project is currently at 40 percent. However, you can download a trial right now to test the project in action. The screenshots on the site show the likes an Erdtree, what look like Margit, the Fell Omen, and even one of the terrifying mausoleums that are a mystery. It's more about the style of Elden Ring than the gameplay experience, but you could try combining the map with the Elden Ring mod pack we wrote about just a few weeks ago.
