MECCA Sunday School Policies and Procedures

- 1) Regular and prompt attendance is vital to developing a sense of community and acquiring Islamic knowledge. Students are expected to be at school and prepared to learn, and teachers will be positively rewarding students who are on time and in attendance of the assembly at 9:45 am. An excess of 5 absences and/or tardies may result in the need of the child to repeat the year.
- 2) Drop off and pick up of students will be from the back entrance of the masjid, and students will proceed to the gym for morning assembly at 9:45 and for dismissal at 2:15. Due to overtime hours required for extra supervision, students picked up late may incur fees. The gym will officially be locked at 2:30 pm, and any students waiting for to be picked up thereafter will be waiting at the back entrance.
- 3) MECCA School students will dress in appropriate and Islamic attire while attending school. Boys will be asked to wear long pants and girls in 5th grade or higher will be asked to wear long skirts or Abayahs. Boys wearing shorts or girls wearing pants will be given a warning the first week. They may be asked to return home if the above dress code is not adhered to. Girls are reminded to bring headscarves for prayer and Quran classes as well.
- 4) Any student caught tampering with or damaging school property shall be held financially liable for the damage.
- 5) Students may not bring electronics or games to class. Teachers may take possession of such items if found to be causing classroom disruptions.
- 6) Should a child become ill or injured while at school, parents will be contacted. If immediate medical attention is required, paramedics will be called.
- 7) Students may bring a sack lunch or snack to school each week. We will also be providing Pizza Track pizza, snacks, and drinks for purchase. The following items and will be available at the listed pricing:

- 8) Parents are kindly requested not to visit classrooms while learning is taking place. If a parent must speak to the teacher, an appointment will gladly be scheduled before or after school.
- 9) Classroom behavior will be managed by the teacher. The school teacher will provide the students with a behavior system including positive incentives as well as consequences for repeated transgressions by the student. Extreme behavior may warrant consequences such as missing recess, phone call home, or parent conference if necessary.
- 10) In order to establish a true community spirit within our Sunday school, it is essential that there is continued positive communication between the parents, teachers, and administration. OURAN RECITATION

MECCA Center will be adopting a new curriculum this year to improve our students' reading of the Quran and incorporating into our schedule as a Quran recitation class. **AlBidayeh**, the recitation curriculum developed by Sheikh Ahmed AlSheikhi, will be implemented by our Quran recitation teachers, who have been attending training sessions and workshops conducted by Sheikh Ahmed throughout the summer to enhance their teaching methods and strategies for this curriculum.

QURAN STUDIES CURRICULUM

In order to encourage students to review the surahs they memorized this year and to help them establish a continued connection with the Quran, MECCA Sunday School seeks to enhance its Quran curriculum and to encourage its students to eventually memorize a whole Juz' (chapter) of the Quran in the Quran Studies class.

The following is the list of surahs that each class will study the meanings of and memorize Insha'Allah:

PRESCHOOL: AlFatiha, AlNas, AlIkhlas, AlFalaq, AlKawthar, AlMasad, AlAsr, AlQuraish, AyatKursi

KINDERGARTEN: Review, AlNasr, AlKafiroon, AlMa'aoon, AlFil, AlHumaza AlTakathur, AlQariya'

1st GRADE: Review, Al-A'adiyat, Al-Zalzalah, Al-Bayyinah, Al-Qadr, Al-Teen, Al-Alaq, AlSharah,

2nd GRADE: Review, AlDuha, Al-Layl, Al-Shams, Al-Balad, Al-Fajr

3rd GRADE: Review, Al-Ghashiyah, Al-A'ala, Al-Tariq, Al-Buruj, Al-Inshiqaq

4th GRADE: Review, Al-Mutaffifeen, Al-Infitar, Al-Takwir,

5th GRADE: Review, Abasa, Al-Naziat, Al-Naba'

6th GRADE and up: Students are introduced to the science of tajweed and will study longer surahs decided upon with their teachers such as YaSin, Wagia'ah, Lugman, Mulk, Sajdeh, Insan, and others.

ISLAMIC STUDIES CURRICULUM

The **Weekend School Islamic Studies** series will be distributed and used by the students this year. Teachers also use supporting curriculum such as **I Love Islam** series with progressive teaching methods to enhance learning.

ARABIC CURRICULUM

The *Afaq Arabic series* is the main focus of the Arabic curriculum, while the *Iqra' Arabic series* is supplemented in several classes for those students that are beginner Arabic learners. In addition, the *AlBidaya Quran reading curriculum* and text will be incorporated in the Quran recitation classes, insha'Allah. Teachers also use various Arabic resources and teaching strategies to enhance the learning of their students.
