INFORMATION TO READ

MDAT – GoG reports are primarily based upon information sent by vessels using the Voluntary Reporting Scheme. Masters and CSOs are encouraged to report events or sightings as early as possible, with as much detail as possible to allow MDAT-GOG to initiate the appropriate response.

Sometimes incomplete reports cause delay to the issue of Warnings or Advisories and our ability to contact Local Law Enforcement assets for assistance. Masters are requested to call MDAT-GoG (+33 298 228888) at the time of any incident occurring. This phone number is monitored permanently (24/7).

It is requested the Masters contact MDAT-GoG as soon as possible to facilitate quick actions by the MDAT-GoG and their regional contacts.

Details can be found on SHOM Chart 8801CSD or UKHO Chart Q6114, 30 June 2016, to allow them to report their vessels when transiting the revised Voluntary Reporting Area (VRA), also described on both security charts with the MDAT-GOG, using the email address watchkeepers@mdat-gog.org



On 2nd July 2020 at approx, 0345UTC, In position 03°52′N–006°59′E (200° / 35nm off Bonny, NIGERIA) The OKWORI oilfield. Despite the presence of a SECURITY vessel, two fast moving boats, with unknown amount of armed pesons on board was able to attack the vessel. The SECURITY vessel was lured away by a small wooden boat used as a decoy. No further detail available.
BOARDING	02 JUL 2020	183°/152nm Cotonou, Benin	MDAT-GOG has received information about a Boarding on a MV (Name withheld). On 2 nd July 2020 at approx, 2220UTC, In position 03°49'N – 002°25'E (183° / 152nm off Cotonou, BENIN) The MV was attacked by one small moving boat. Unknow amount of persons Boarded the MV. No further detail available.
