Greetings to all YMCA KL Members, Volunteers, and Guests,

Firstly, we hope everyone is in good health and safe.

Secondly, as of 18 March 2020, Wednesday, the YMCA of Kuala Lumpur is taking necessary measures to officially temporarily close all Facilities in YMCA KL in response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic and therefore halt all Courses, Activities, Events and Training Sessions until 15 April 2020, Wednesday, when further action will be taken by our Management.

In line with the latest directive from the Malaysian Government, the YMCA of Kuala Lumpur Hostel will operate until the last check-out from the existing in-house guests and no additional check-ins are allowed for new guest effective on 18 March 2020 until further notice.

This closure is not to be taken lightly as YMCA KL moves in compliance with recommendations for Movement Control Order by the Government of Malaysia. This measure directly affects over 4,000 members, programs, courses, training and child care participants, plus our many staff and volunteers. Please know that the YMCA of Kuala Lumpur considers this closure the best way we can serve the YMCA KL Family and the Klang Valley community at large.
