Introduction: Memorizing Scripture but showing inconsistency Key Question: How do you show God has transformed you to prove His grace is true, yet not imply your godliness earns His Grace? Answer: Teach what accords with sound doctrine

- I. Teach Sound Doctrine (2:1) This requires that we know...
 - a. Doctrine = Biblical Teaching
 - b. Sound Doctrine = Teaching that protects the church from disease

Example: Churches dividing over...

- 1. Virgin Birth
- 2. Inerrancy of scripture
- 3. Substitutionary Atonement
- 4. Miracles
- 5. Physical Resurrection

Church always protected by those teaching "sound doctrine"

- II. Teach what "accords with" Sound Doctrine (2:1)
 - a. The content of Sound Doctrine (Biblical Teaching) 1:1-2
 - 1. Jesus is the Christ (1:1a)
 - 2. Faith is our Connection (1:1b)
 - 3. God is our Connector (1:1-2)
 - b. The consequences of Sound Doctrine

(biblical teaching)

- 1. The Character of Spiritual Fathers Shows Grace (2:2a)
- 2. The Influence of Spiritual Fathers Spreads Grace (2:2b)
