Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 ROCKAWAY BAY will be making the first start of his career for trainer Tony O'Sullivan. He comes into this with two qualifiers under his belt and most recently finished as the runner-up to Betterhavemymoney, who debuted in an OSS Gold event and was an impressive winner by more than four lengths. We liked the body language of this one as he came to the line in that latest morning prep, as he was never really asked in the stretch before hitting the wire in his own mile time of 1:56.1. He is out of the same mare that produced Doonbeg, a winner of more than \$800,000. This son of A Rocknroll Dance flashed final quarter speed of 27.2 on June 12th and might be ready to win at first asking. Sylvain Filion was aboard for both qualifiers and sticks with this colt over another.

#2 TRUE BLUE LINDY was a \$25,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale and will now make his lifetime debut for Carl Jamieson. He won by open lengths in his lone qualifier on June 12th and was under some encouragement to do so by Jamieson. He managed to widen his margin in deep stretch and fire home in 27.2 and is one of the logical main players in the contest.

#1 STRIKING IMPACT was a \$50,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will now make the first start of his life for trainer Carmen Auciello. He was a winner in his most recent qualifying tilt on July 2nd when he tripped the wire in 1:59.2 but did get some reminders from McNair in the stretch drive. This son of Always B Miki merits respect but we prefer the two above.

#8 WORLD FOR TWO is one of four in the race that already have a parimutuel start under their belt. He got away in the three-hole and sat an inside trip before finishing fourth. He could not really make a forward move in the stretch, as the field blasted home and this he paced his own final panel in 26.3. This gelding should not be dismissed.

#3 KIPPER WHIPR SNIPR is homebred for Edward Wilson that will be sent out for the first start of his career in this OSS Gold event by conditioner Rob Fellows. His latest qualifier was an eye-catching one, as he went to the lead before the halfway point and then opened a huge margin on his rivals to score by nearly 12 lengths under the wire. This son of Royalty For Life was never asked by Roy but still bolted home in 28.2. He has progressed well through his two morning preps and might be difficult to beat if he takes another step forward tonight.

#7 ROYAL CHAMPANE made the first start of his career last week against a solid group of rookies and was never in contention when he got away ninth off the gate from the six-hole. He trotted his back-half in 58.1 with a final panel of 28.2 and was doing his best work in the final eighth of a mile. This colt hails from rock-solid connections and might get put into play when the chips are down in this gold tilt.

#4 RENEGADE GYPSY took support to the tune of 6/5 in his lifetime debut on June 29th and managed to hold on by a head after taking the lead in the stretch drive. He was in the two-hole turning for home, but the front-runner made a miscue and that allowed this one to shoot up the cones. This son of Archangel looked good in both of his qualifying efforts leading up to that start and can land on the ticket in here.

#5 ESPLOSIONE is one of two in the contest that will be making the third start of his career. He did not have much of a chance in his first two, as he got away eighth off the gate in both of those contests. This son on Kadabra came home in 27.3 on June 24th to get fifth but then bothered on the final turn last time and was unable to get a prize. He picks up Trevor Henry this time around and might be worth a look.

#4 A ROYAL HIT made multiple moves in his lifetime debut here on June 29th before only getting beat by a neck on the wire. He was used hard early to get to the early lead from the seven-hole but then got shuffled back to the three-hole by the halfway point. This gelding then ended up second-over on the final turn and gamely chased in the stretch before missing by a slim margin at the wire. Trainer Robert Robinson hands the lines over to Chris Christoforou for this gold tilt and this son of Royalty For Life is worth some thought.

#6 DRINKS AT HOME was a \$47,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg and will now have his lifetime debut for trainer Luc Blais. He is half-brother to Macho Martini, who had tremendous success in the OSS program last season. This colt progressed well through his two morning preps and was an impressive winner on June 25th when he was trotting smoothly on the front-end through a score in 2:00.4 with a final panel in 28.4. The connections and bloodline merits respect but we will side with the two above.

#5 MR FRITTER closed well to be fourth in his lifetime debut on June 29th and finished alongside our second choice under the wire. He trotted his back-half in 58.1 and his final panel in 29 seconds flat. This son of Muscle Mass might take a step forward in his follow-up try and is worth using in exotics.

#2 DELIGHT BAYAMA is a homebred for Bayama Farms that will be sent out for the first start of her career by trainer Jean Tourigny. She was under tight lines to Filion in the stretch in her latest qualifier and paced home in 28.2. This filly was not asked to produce more than the line shows but might take a step forward tonight in her first race under the lights. Filion opted to drive this one over two others in the race and that decision further makes her one to consider.

#1 MOTOVATION is a homebred that will be making her lifetime debut for trainer and driver Phil Hudon. She was a going away winner in her lone qualifier and was doing her best work late when she paced her final quarter in 27.3. This filly appeared to be in hand to Hudon at the wire and is not without a chance in here.

#6 DIXIE STAR N dropped down to this level in her latest and tried to leave out for the early lead from the eight-hole but made a bobble in the opening turn after getting sent wide through a hot opening clip of 26.4. She was gathered up by Drury and then continued on to challenge first-over through a half in 55.4. This mare faded in the stretch to be seventh but had every reason to do so after a travelling a tumultuous journey. She gets a better starting spot on the center of the gate and might be tough to beat with a better trip.

#1 SUNDAY AFTERNOON ships back up to Mohawk Park from the Meadowlands and will now race out of the barn of Isaac Waxman. The last time we saw her was before the shutdown in March when she was a winner at the level above this and hit the board in three out of four. She now gets reunited with McNair, who has driven her to five of her 18 lifetime victories. This mare deserves respect and likely the one to beat.

#5 ESPRIT DEQUIPE drops down to the bottom level after finishing ninth at nearly 110-1 in a tough version of NW5500L5 in her latest. It was her first start in over a month, and she might be ready to take a big step forward now that she is on a regular rotation. She draws the center of the gate and is worth considering.

#7 OUTLAW IMAHOTVIXEN spent her last two at the level above this and was on the edges in both of those starts. She was a runner-up to Sweet Heaven at Grand River Raceway in her first start back on June 16th and should be competitive with this group.

#2 TAKEYOURBREATHAWAY drops down to the bottom level and is typically a contender when she gets to this class. This will make just the third time that Filion will be aboard this mare and she is worth using on the bottom end of exotics, especially if the price is robust.

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
