#### 1) By email:

Take a photograph of your collage, email it to <u>cpp@creativebasildon.co.uk</u> along with your name and post code. Need to know how to photograph your collages? Visit our website to watch a video tutorial.

## 2) In person:

Write your name, email address and post code on the back of the collage. A list of libraries where you can drop your collages off can be found on our website.

We have included glue in the packs, but if you run out, you can mix water, flour and salt to make your own. There are also scissors included in the packs so children may need to be supervised.
