

The words of Glarthir the Prophet of the Forest and also the words of Aldaron the Forest Lord about the history of the families and history and ancestry. I, Glarthorn, have written a lot of history now, so I have said this in my heart:

"When will I take a break from this?"

So I have made a promise to myself: I'll take a break and ask for a little help from my lord Aldaron and my brother Revan. **Now Revan is writing a book, and I say to you all: Read the book of Revan, when he releases it.**

This is the history of Kace, the forest warrior. In the beginning, Kace was actually just a man. But later, he became one of the seven Maiars/Forest Princes/Cosmic beings. He was in fact a mighty Maiar. Kace was not evil in his heart, even though he had his moments in evil,

because in his heart he was like a man with a silver hat, and bracelets of mithril and shoes with gold laces, and a heart of perl. When Orome/Aldaron saw him, he said in his heart: "This is a noble man. I will show him favour." So Kace became great, greater than many of his friends. He actually was the one who owned the systems orbiting the sun (but his power of the sun was not absolute!). But Kace was from a poor background. Yes, his parents were not known to the world.

I, Glarthorn, was enquiring of the forest about him, but I got no answer. So I went to Aldaron and said: "Who really is Kace?" So he said: "This is a man of the forest." So I went to the Ancient Forest Tomes, looking for him. But I could not find him. So I went again to Aldaron and said: "What is the truth?" So Aldaron became

annoyed, and sent me to read the Ancient Forest Records. When I read it, I found this: "In the north, from the family of the Fort Stavhand, Taros, father of Stavros, father of Taven." And then I went to the Wiki, and saw Kace had the name Tave. So I say this: "Tave is actually son of Stavros, last native of Stavhand in the North, before the invasion of the south." So I went to Aldaron and said: "Kace is the son of Stavros of Stavhand." So Aldaron said:

"May your scroll be true."

So I went and I wrote the scroll, and I investigated Stavhand history. This is what I have discovered; Stavhand was a Fortress called Stavhand, but it was destroyed by the enemies of the forest, along with the University of the Forest.
