About the project

It aims to create a new perspective on our countries through first-hand experience of participating interns. It offers a two-week internship, in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina or Montenegro to 12 young people, individually placed to work and gain professional experience for two weeks in one NGO in the hosting country that matches their profile. All interns will be placed abroad, NOT on the country of origin, creating thus a network of opinion-changers at NGO level.

If you are eager to know the region and like many of us, feel home in the neighbouring countries, then this is your chance to know your peers in real working settings, as an intern in one of the three hosting countries.

This project will enable young people to be part of working environments in NGOs, and allowing them to experience life in the neighbouring country from a new perspective.

We aim

New perspectives, experiences, networks and togetherness on the internship scheme. By promoting their independent experience and opinion, interns will be able to think in a broader term for their own personal goals and careers.

Thinking “We in the Balkans” is more prestigious and powerful than thinking “We in my country”. The new networks, new internships, experiences, promotions and change of perspectives are very likely to bring a bigger, a more positive change into the youth mindset, and wider.



We expect from interns to:

- Assist and contribute to the team.
- Learn and gain experience.
- Job shadow, work and walk with us.
- Write an article on the experience.
- Continuous stories, ideas, pictures, impressions, and videos.
- Generated the next level project on the Summer School.

Project activities:

- 12 interns x two week internship each
- 3 Open Days
- 3 Round table discussions
- Mentoring and motivational sessions
- Internship exchange
- Featured articles written by interns
- Final closing event in Montenegro

In a nutshell:

- The project provides two-week internship, May and September 2022. Linking NGOs with interns, volunteers or students who want to gain working experience in one of the neighbouring countries: Albania, BiH, or Montenegro
- 12 young people will be selected
- 4 interns from each country
- They choose the thematic and we find the hosting NGO.
- Individually placed to work and gain professional experience
- Abroad, NOT on the country of origin
- Certificate and reference issued at the end of the internship
