## TENSION

THE TENSION FOR THIS DESIGN IS

6 stitches to one inch.

Check your tension - if less stitches use a finer needle, if more use a coarser needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

K knit, p purl, sts stitches, tog together, s1 slip one stitch knitways, st-st stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl), tbl through back of loops, yfwd yarn forward, inc increase(ing), dec decreasing, D.K. Double Knitting.

After casting off stitches for shaping, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

N.B. For the small size read the instructions as given.

For the large size read the figures within the brackets.

N.B. MATERIALS: THE COAT, LEGGINETTES AND CAP can be worked from

## THE COAT

### MEASUREMENTS

Actual size

Full length

Sleeve length or length required

20½	21½	ins
13	14	ins
7	8	ins

## MATERIALS

BABY DOUBLE KNITTING Wool }  
DOUBLE KNITTING Wool }  
DOUBLE CREPE Wool }  
SUPER NYLON D.K. }

7	8	balls
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1 Pair No. 8 Knitting Needles.

3 Buttons.

## THE BACK

Cast on 91 [97] sts.

1ST Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.

Repeat 1st row 7 times.

Proceed as follows:-

Proceed in st-st until work measures 7½ [8] inches from commencement, ending on wrong side of work.

### Shape the Waist

As the shapings (may) differ for the various ages follow the headings for the age required.

#### 6 months only

1ST Row. K2tog, k2, \* k2tog, k1, repeat from \* to last 6 sts, k2tog, k2, k2tog. 61 sts.

#### 9 months only

1ST Row. K2tog, (k2, k2tog) twice, (k1, k2tog) 12 times, k1, k3tog, (k1, k2tog) 13 times, (k2, k2tog) twice. [65] sts.

# BOY'S PRAM SET

6 AND 9 MONTHS

## 6 and 9 months

2ND Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.

Repeat 2nd row 6 times.

9TH Row. S1, knit to end of row.

10TH Row. S1, purl to last st, k1.

Keeping continuity of st-st (throughout) work 2 rows without shaping.

### Shape for the Armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows.

Work 28 [32] rows dec once at each end of next and every alternate row. 25 [25] sts.

Work 4 [4] rows dec once at each end of every row. 17 [17] sts.

Cast off.

## THE RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 49 [53] sts.

1ST Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.

Repeat 1st row 7 times dec once at beginning of last row for 9 months only. 49 [52] sts.

Proceed as follows.

1ST Row. S1, (k1, p1) 3 times, knit to end of row.

2ND Row. S1, purl to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1.

Keeping continuity of moss st border and st-st (throughout) continue until work measures same as The Back to Shape the Waist, ending on wrong side of work.

### Shape the Waist

1ST Row. S1, (k1, p1) 3 times, \* k2tog, k1, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, k3tog. 34 [36] sts.

2ND Row. S1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.

3RD Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to end of row.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows twice then 2nd row once.

9TH Row. S1, (k1, p1) 3 times, knit to end of row.

10TH Row. S1, purl to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1.

Repeat 9th and 10th rows once then 9th row once.

### Shape for the Armhole

NEXT Row. Cast off 4 sts purlways, purl to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1.

Work 22 [22] rows dec once at armhole edge in next and every alternate row. 19 [21] sts.

### Shape the Neck

NEXT Row. Cast off 8 sts in pattern knit to last 2 sts, k2tog.

NEXT Row. S1, purl to last st, k1.

Work 3 rows dec once at neck edge in every row at same time dec once at armhole edge in next and following alternate row. 5 [7] sts.

Work 1 [5] rows dec once at armhole edge only in 2nd and following alternate row. 5 [5] sts.

Work 2 [2] rows dec once at armhole edge only in every row. 3 [3] sts.

NEXT Row. S1, k2tog.

NEXT Row. K2tog. Fasten off.

## THE LEFT FRONT

Cast on 49 [53] sts.

1ST Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.

Repeat 1st row 7 times dec once at end of last row for 9 months only. 49 [52] sts.

Proceed as follows:-

1ST Row. S1, knit to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1.

# SIRDAR

2ND Row. S1, (k1, p1) 3 times, purl to last st, k1.  
 Keeping continuity of st-st and moss st border (throughout) continue until work measures same as The Back to Shape the Waist, ending on wrong side of work.

## Shape the Waist

1ST Row. K3tog, \* k1, k2tog, repeat from \* to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1. 34 [36] sts.  
 2ND Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to end of row.  
 3RD Row. S1, \* p1, k1, repeat from to last st, k1.  
 4TH Row. Like 2nd row.  
 5TH Row. S1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last 5 sts, cast off 2 sts, k2.  
 6TH Row. S1, k1, p1, cast on 2 sts, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to end of row.  
 Repeat 3rd row once then 2nd row once.  
 9TH Row. S1, knit to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1.  
 10TH Row. S1, (k1, p1) 3 times, purl to last st, k1.  
 Repeat 9th and 10th rows once.

## Shape for the Armhole

NEXT Row. Cast off 4 sts, knit to last 7 sts, (p1, k1) 3 times, k1.  
 NEXT Row. S1, (k1, p1) 3 times, purl to last st, k1.  
 Work 23 [23] rows dec once at armhole edge in next and every alternate row at same time working a buttonhole in 5th and 6th, and 19th and 20th rows. 18 [20] sts.

## Shape the Neck

NEXT Row. Cast off 8 sts in pattern, purl to last st, k1.  
 Work 3 rows dec once at armhole edge in next and following alternate row at same time dec once at neck edge in every row. 5 [7] sts.  
 Work 1 [5] rows dec once at armhole edge only in 2nd and following alternate row. 5 [5] sts.  
 Work 2 [2] rows dec once at armhole edge only in every row. 3 [3] sts.  
 NEXT Row. K2tog, k1.  
 NEXT Row. K2tog. Fasten off.

## THE SLEEVES

(Both alike)

Cast on 31 [37] sts.  
 1ST Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.  
 Repeat 1st row 7 times inc once at end of last row. 32 [38] sts.  
 Proceed in st-st inc once at each end of 5th and every following 6th row until there are 40 [46] sts on needle.  
 Inc once at each end of every following 4th row until there are 44 [50] sts on needle.  
 Continue without shaping until work measures 7 [8] inches from commencement, or length required, ending on wrong side of work.

## Shape for the Top

Cast off 4 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows.  
 As the shapings (may) differ for the various ages follow the headings for the age required.

### 6 months only

Work 4 rows dec once at each end of 1st row. 34 sts.

### 6 and 9 months

Work 23 [36] rows dec once at each end of next and every alternate row. 6 [6] sts. Cast off.

## THE COLLAR

Cast on 53 [57] sts.  
 1ST Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.  
 Repeat 1st row 15 times.  
 Cast off in pattern.

## TO MAKE UP

Read Pressing Instructions. Sew up side and sleeve seams. Placing seam to seam sew decreased edges of sleeves to decreased edges of bodice. Placing right side of collar to wrong side of work and ends of collar 4 sts in from front edges, sew cast off edge of collar in position all round neck edge. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

## THE LEGGINETTES

## MEASUREMENTS

Length of front seam  
 Length of leg seam to toe

## MATERIALS

BABY DOUBLE KNITTING Wool  
 DOUBLE KNITTING Wool  
 DOUBLE CREPE Wool  
 SUPER NYLON D.K.

5	6	balls
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1 Pair No. 8 and No. 10 Knitting Needles.  
 4 Buttons.  
 1 Yard Petersham Ribbon.

## THE RIGHT LEG

Using No. 10 needles cast on 68 [72] sts.  
 1ST Row. S1, k2, \* p2, k2, repeat from \* to last st, k1.  
 2ND Row. S1, \* p2, k2, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, p2, k1.  
 Repeat 1st and 2nd rows once.

## THE BUTTONHOLES

NEXT Row. S1, (k2, p2) 4 times, k1, turn.  
 Working on these 18 [18] sts only work 4 rows in rib.  
 Break off yarn.  
 With right side of work facing, rejoin yarn to remaining 50 [54] sts and proceed as follows:-  
 NEXT Row. K1, (p2, k2) 7 [8] times, p2, k1, turn.  
 Working on these 32 [36] sts only work 4 rows in rib.  
 Break off yarn.  
 With right side of work facing, rejoin yarn to remaining 18 [18] sts and proceed as follows:-  
 NEXT Row. K1, (p2, k2) 4 times, k1, turn.  
 Working on these 18 [18] sts only work 4 rows in rib.  
 NEXT Row. Work across 68 [72] sts as follows:- s1, \* p2, k2 repeat from \* to last 3 sts, p2, k1.  
 Work 4 rows in rib. \*\*  
 Change to No. 8 needles and proceed as follows:-  
 1ST Row. S1, knit to end of row.  
 2ND Row. S1, purl to last st, k1.  
 3RD Row. S1, k11, turn.  
 4TH, 6TH AND 8TH ROWS. Purl to last st, k1.  
 5TH Row. S1, k21, turn.  
 7TH Row. S1, k31, turn.  
 9TH Row. S1, k41, turn.  
 10TH Row. Purl to last st, k1.  
 Repeat 1st and 2nd rows 3 times.  
 \*\*\*

Continue in st-st inc once at each end of next and every following 6th row until there are 82 [86] sts on needle.  
 Continue without shaping until short side of work measures 9 [9½] inches from commencement, ending on wrong side of work.

## Shape the Leg

Continue in st-st dec once at each end of next and every alternate row until 36 [36] sts remain.  
 Commencing with a purl row work 3 rows without shaping.

# SIRDAR

Change to No. 10 needles and proceed as follows:-  
 1ST Row. S1, k2, \* p2, k2, repeat from \* to last st, k1.  
 2ND Row. S1, \* p2, k2, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, p2, k1.  
 Repeat 1st and 2nd rows 3 times.  
 Change to No. 8 needles and proceed as follows:-  
 Work 22 [24] rows in st-st without shaping.

## Shape the Toe

1ST Row. S1, k2tog tbl, k12, k2tog, k2, k2tog tbl, k12, k2tog, k1.  
 2ND AND 4TH ROWS. S1, purl to last st, k1.  
 3RD Row. S1, k2tog tbl, k10, k2tog, k2, k2tog tbl, k10, k2tog, k1.  
 5TH Row. S1, k2tog tbl, k8, k2tog, k2, k2tog tbl, k8, k2tog, k1.  
 6TH Row. K2tog, purl to last 2 sts, k2tog. (22 sts). Cast off.

## THE LEFT LEG

Using No. 10 needles cast on 68 [72] sts.  
 Work exactly as given for The Right Leg until \*\* is reached.  
 Change to No. 8 needles and proceed as follows:-  
 1ST Row. S1, knit to end of row.  
 2ND Row. S1, purl to last st, k1.  
 Repeat 1st row once.  
 4TH Row. S1, p11, turn.  
 5TH, 7TH AND 9TH ROWS. Knit to end of row.  
 6TH Row. S1, p21, turn.  
 8TH Row. S1, p31, turn.  
 10TH Row. S1, p41, turn.  
 11TH Row. Knit to end of row.  
 Commencing with a purl row work 5 rows in st-st without shaping.

## TO MAKE UP

Complete from \*\*\* as given for The Right Leg.  
 Read Pressing Instructions. Sew up front, back, leg and foot seams. Cut Petersham ribbon in half. Sew one button to each end of each piece of Petersham ribbon and button to legginettes.

## MEASUREMENTS

Width all round face 13½ | 14 ins

## MATERIALS

BABY DOUBLE KNITTING Wool  
 DOUBLE KNITTING Wool  
 DOUBLE CREPE Wool  
 SUPER NYLON D.K.  
 1 Pair No. 8 and No. 10 Knitting Needles. 2 | 2 balls

## GENERAL PRESSING INSTRUCTIONS

WOOL	— under damp cloth — hot iron.	WOOL and MAN MADE FIBRES	— under dry cloth — warm iron — light press.
NYLON	— under dry cloth — warm iron.	NYLON and COTTON	— under damp cloth — hot iron.
MOHAIR	— under damp cloth — hot iron — light pressure.	COURTELLE	— DO NOT PRESS.

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## THE CAP

Using No. 8 needles cast on 89 [93] sts.

1ST Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.  
 Repeat 1st row 13 times.  
 Change to No. 10 needles and proceed as follows:-  
 1ST Row. S1, k4 [6], \* k2tog, k9, repeat from \* to last 7 [9] sts, k2tog, k5 [7]. 81 [85] sts.  
 2ND Row. S1, k1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.  
 3RD Row. S1, \* p1, k1, repeat from \* to end of row.  
 Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 5 times.  
 Change to No. 8 needles and proceed as follows:-  
 Proceed in st-st until work measures 1¾ [2] inches from commencement of st-st, ending on wrong side of work, dec once at end of last row. 80 [84] sts.

## Shape the Crown

1ST Row. \* K2tog, k14 [12], repeat from \* to end of row.  
 2ND AND EVERY ALTERNATE ROW. S1, knit to end of row.  
 3RD Row. \* K2tog, k13 [11], repeat from \* to end of row.  
 Continue in this manner working 1st less between dec in next and every alternate row until 20 [12] sts remain.  
 NEXT Row. S1, \* k3tog, [k2tog], repeat from \* to last st, k1. 8 [7] sts.  
 Break off yarn, run yarn through remaining sts, draw up and fasten off.

## THE EAR FLAPS

(Both alike for both sizes)

Using No. 8 needles cast on 2 sts.  
 1ST Row. (Inc once in next st) twice.  
 2ND, 4TH AND 6TH ROWS. S1, knit to end of row.  
 3RD Row. S1, (inc once in next st) twice, k1.  
 5TH Row. S1, (inc once in next st, k1) twice, k1.  
 7TH Row. S1, inc once in next st, knit to last 3 sts, inc once in next st, k2.  
 8TH Row. S1, knit to end of row.  
 Repeat 7th and 8th rows 2 [3] times. 14 [16] sts.  
 Repeat 8th row 10 times. Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

Read Pressing Instructions. With right side of work facing, commencing at cast on edge, sew up seam for 1½ [1½] inches, turn work inside out and sew up remainder of seam. Turn work right side out and turn back brim. Sew cast off edge of ear flaps to edge of cap 1¾ [2] inches in from back seam. Using 4 strands of yarn make 2 twisted cords 12 inches in length and sew to ear flaps. Make a neat knot at end of each cord and leave about 1 inch of yarn showing to form a tassel.
