EARLY CHILDHOOD CRAFT | LESSON 2

SEEK AND FIND BINOCULARS

This week we are learning about the Parable of the Lost Sheep. In this story, Jesus tells us about a man who leaves ninety-nine of his sheep to find the one lost sheep. Jesus used this story to illustrate how God loves and cares for each of us the same and wants us to be in heaven with Him. When we choose to belong to God's family, we will then be able to spend forever with God one day in heaven!



PREP BEFORE SERVICE

- 1. Glue or tape two cardboard craft tubes together to create binoculars.
- 2. Print the binocular wrapper printable onto white paper and cut out.

DURING THE SERVICE

- 1. Distribute coloring medium to each table.
- 2. Give one binocular wrapper to each child and help them write their name on it.
- 3. Invite the children to color their binocular wrapper.
- 4. Remind the children of the teaching objective while they color and talk with them about how much God loves them and wants them to be in heaven with Him.
- 5. When each child is done, attach the wrapper to the tube with tape or glue.
