Prošla su točno dva desetljeća kako je GNK Dinamo osmislio zahtjevan i hvalevrijedan projekt organizacije snažnog međunarodnog turnira na kojem bi okupljao mlade momčadi i talente širom svijeta. Danas s iznimnim ponosom možemo najaviti da nas ovoga ljeta čeka „okrugla“ obljetnica, 20. izdanje Međunarodnog memorijalnog juniorskog turnira Mladen Ramljak, natjecanja koje se u vrlo kratkom vremenu prometnulo u jedno od prestižnijih u Europi i svijetu.

Snagu, kvalitetu i značenje turnira možda je najbolje ilustrirati s dva zanimljiva detalja: a) u prvom je izdanju 2003. godine sudjelovao tadašnji Dinamov junior Luka Modrić, današnji kapetan hrvatske reprezentacije, zvijezda Reala i najbolji igrač svijeta 2018. godine; b) na turniru 2021. godine najboljim je igračem proglašen turski vezist Arda Güler iz Fenerbahçea, mladi nogometaš koji je ovoga ljeta u velikom transferu prešao u Real.

GNK Dinamo nositelj je sportske kvalitete po pitanju razvoja igrača na području Hrvatske pa i Europe. Glavna je zadaća navikavanje mladih igrača na nogomet visokoga intenziteta, na veliki pritisak, bilo fizički, psihološki, medijski... Konačni je cilj procesa oblikovanje i formiranje darovitih nogometaša kako bi spremni izašli na veliku scenu. Pritom se sučeljavaju sa zahtjevnim rasporedom i različitim vrstama iskušenja i u tom kontekstu iznimno važna uloga pripada turniru Mladen Ramljak.

Mladi igrači tako imaju priliku izaći iz svoje zone komfora, a to znači zaigrati u snažnijoj konkurenciji, a istodobno sučeliti se s različitim stilovima igre, različitim nogometnim kulturama. Upravo je sudjelovanje na brojnim međunarodnim turnirima jedan od glavnih fokusa naše nogometne škole. Dinamovi su juniori, primjerice, samo prošle sezone odigrali 59 utakmica, što na domaćoj, a što na međunarodnoj sceni.

U svih 20 izdanja turnira, od 2003. godine, nastupilo je čak 75 različitih klubova ili reprezentacija, i to iz 34 zemlje s 5 kontinenata. Sudjelovalo je čak 10 klupskih kontinentalnih prvaka od kojih šest osvajača UEFA Kupa/Lige prvaka, dva pobjednika Cope Libertadores i dva osvajača azijske Lige prvaka . I u ovogodišnjem jubilarnom izdanju očekuje nas snažan i kvalitetan turnir s velikim svjetskim klubovima. Vjerujem da ćemo svi zajedno uživati u nogometnoj mladosti, zanimljivim utakmicama, zajedničkom druženju. Dobro nam došli dragi prijatelji!



Exactly two decades have passed since GNK Dinamo conceived an ambitious and commendable project of organizing a strong international tournament that would bring together young teams and talents from around the world. Today, with exceptional pride, we can announce that this summer, we are celebrating the "milestone" anniversary, the 20th edition of the International Memorial U-19 Tournament Mladen Ramljak, an event that has quickly become one of the prestigious competitions in Europe and the world in youth categories.

The strength, quality, and significance of the Tournament are perhaps best illustrated by two interesting details: a) Luka Modrić, former GNK Dinamo Academy player, now the longtime captain of the Croatian national team, a star at Real Madrid and the 2018 Ballon d'Or winner, played in the first edition of the Tournament in 2003; b) in the 2021 edition of the Tournament, the Best Player Award went to the Turkish midfielder Arda Güler from Fenerbahçe, a young footballer who made a big transfer move to Real Madrid this summer.

GNK Dinamo is a leader in sports quality when it comes to player development in Croatia and even Europe. Its main task is to adjust young players to high-intensity football, immense pressure, both physical, psychological, and media-related. The ultimate goal of this process is to shape and form talented footballers to be ready for the big stage. In this context, the Mladen Ramljak Tournament.

Participating in the Tournament allows young players to step out of their comfort zones, meaning they get to play against stronger competition and confront different playing styles and football cultures. In fact, involvement in numerous international tournaments is one of the main focuses of our football school. For example, Dinamo Academy players participated in a total of 59 matches just last season, both domestically and internationally.

Over the course of the 20 editions of the Tournament since 2003, as many as 75 different clubs or national teams from 34 countries across 5 continents have participated. There were even 10 club continental champions among the participants, including six UEFA Cup/Champions League winners, two Copa Libertadores winners, and two Asian Champions League winners.

In this year's anniversary edition, we can also look forward to a strong and high-quality Tournament featuring some of the world's top clubs. I believe that we will all enjoy the footballing youth, exciting matches, and the fellowship. Welcome, dear friends!





Protiv Juventusa je igrao stopera, Eintrachtove je jurišnike zaustavljao u ulozi libera, Leedsove je trenere namučio suzbijajući svaki nasrtaj Engleza prema Dinamovim vratima... Takav je bio – Mladen Ramljak! Jedan od najboljih braniča u povijesti maksimirskoga kluba. Nažalost, tragično je preminuo od posljedica prometne nesreće 13. rujna 1978. Bile su mu tek 33 godine.

U spomen na svog proslavljenog i nikad prežaljenog nogometaša Dinamo od 2003. godine organizira tradicionalni međunarodni juniorski turnir „Mladen Ramljak“ na kojem sudjeluju ponajbolji klubovi svijeta.

Ramljak je ponikao u maksimirskoj nogometnoj školi, a prvi je put na travnjak uskočio u studenom 1962. kad ga je trener Milan Antolković uvrstio u početnih 11. Novinari su ga tada opisali kao igrača koji idealno sintetizira fizičke kvalitete, inteligenciju i tehničku izrađenost.

Rođen je 1. srpnja 1945. godine u Zagrebu, afirmirao se u Dinamovu juniorskom pogonu. U maksimirskom je klubu proveo dojmljivih 12 sezona, a za to su vrijeme plavi bili finalisti Kupa velesajamskih gradova 1963., četiri godine kasnije i osvojili to natjecanje, a pritom osvajali jugoslavenski Kup 1963., 1965. i 1969. godine. Ramljak je u Dinamovu dresu odigrao 523 utakmice da bi karijeru nastavio u Feyenoordu iz Rotterdama u kojem je proveo četiri pune sezone i pritom osvojio nizozemsko prvenstvo i Kup UEFA 1974. Za jugoslavensku je reprezentaciju upisao je 13 nastupa.

In the game against Juventus he played as a central defender, later he was stopping the Eintracht Frankfurt strikers as a sweeper, he managed to put down every Leeds United attack in the finals... That was the style of play of former GNK Dinamo great, late Mladen Ramljak, the 1967 Inter-Cities Fairs Cup winner. He is remembered as one of the best defenders in the clubs history. Sadly, he lost his life in the tragic car accident on September 13th, 1978. He was only 33...

To honour our great player GNK Dinamo organizes the International Memorial Youth Tournament starting from 2003.

Ramljak was born on July 1st, 1945 in Zagreb. He started his career in GNK Dinamo as a 13-year-old and made his first team appearance in 1962 when coach Milan Antolković placed him in starting 11. Reporters described him as a player who assembles great physical qualities, intelligence and technical skills.

As a central defender Ramljak spent 12 seasons within GNK Dinamo first team and played 523 games. He appeared in Inter-Cities Fairs Cup finals in 1963 when Dinamo lost to Valencia and in 1967 when they beat Leeds United and won the trophy. He also reached domestic Cup titles in 1963, 1965 and 1969. Later he played for Feyenoord Rotterdam in a four season spell winning the domestic championship title and 1974 UEFA Cup trophy. He also collected 13 caps for former Yugoslavian national team.

Dinamo je još od svojih početaka imao formirane mlađe dobne kategorije, ali nogometna je škola, pod nazivom Hitrec-Kacian, formalno **osnovana 27. prosinca 1967. godine** na inicijativu Zorislava Srebrića, i to nepuna četiri mjeseca nakon što je Dinamo osvojio Kup velesajamskih gradova, kasniji Kup UEFA, današnju Europa ligu.

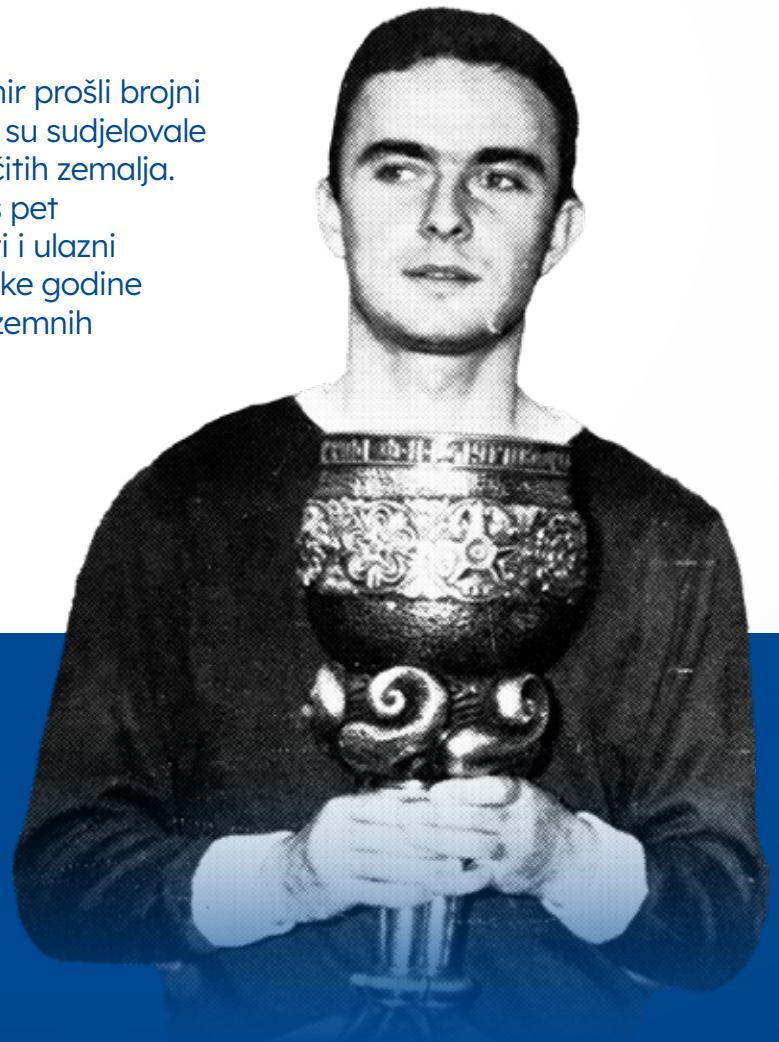
Veliku ulogu u brušenju talenata, privikavanju na natjecateljski duh, ali i u dodatnoj promociji maksimirske škole ima i tradicionalni **Memorijalni turnir Mladen Ramljak**. Prvo je izdanje turnira održano 2003. godine, a memorijal je od tada poprimio aureolu jednoga od cjenjenijih europskih turnira u juniorskoj kategoriji.

Turnir je organiziran u spomen na Dinamova proslavljenog braniča **Mladena Ramljaka** koji je s plavima osvojio najveći trofej u povijesti kluba – **Kup velesajamskih gradova 1967**.

Memorijal je u međuvremenu uspio u ideji koju su organizatori najavili još početkom lipnja 2003. uoči premijernoga izdanja:

” **Želja nam je da turnir postane tradicionalan i da bude jedno od najjačih nadmetanja u toj kategoriji u Europi.**

U prethodnih 19 izdanja kroz ovaj su turnir prošli brojni veliki europski i svjetski klubovi, a nekim su sudjelovale i poneke juniorske reprezentacije iz različitih zemalja. Nastupili su predstavnici čak 34 zemlje s pet kontinenata. Pravo nastupa imaju kadeti i ulazni juniori, a uz domaćina GNK Dinamo svake godine sudjeluje još sedam jakih hrvatskih i inozemnih klubova.



From its very beginning GNK Dinamo Zagreb has formed the clubs youth categories but The Youth Academy was officially introduced on December 27th, 1967. It happened just four months after GNK Dinamo won its most important trophy in club's history: the 1967 Inter-Cities Fairs Cup which emerged into the UEFA Cup, today's UEFA Europa League.

Starting from 2003 our club hosts the annual International Memorial Youth Tournament Mladen Ramljak at the Maksimir Stadium in Zagreb honouring the memory of late GNK Dinamo player. The tournament has a significant role in forming and developing young talents giving them the opportunity to compete against the tough and strong international teams in same youth level.

The Tournament has a 20-year long and proud history. It started back in 2003 and emerged into one of the most prestigious U-19 tournaments in Europe. Beside the host team there are seven more clubs participating in the tournament. Throughout the history, with the 2020 edition being cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic, there were teams from 34 countries and five continents participating in previous 19 editions.





MODRIĆ I ČORLUKA POBJEDNICI PRVOG IZDANJA

U modernoj povijesti hrvatske nogometne reprezentacije, počevši s osamostaljenjem RH, “vatreni” su propustili samo dva od ukupno 14 završnih turnira na svjetskim i europskim prvenstvima. Veličanstvenim izvedbama Hrvatska je upisala povijesne dosege osvojivši broncu na SP 1998. u Francuskoj, potom srebro na SP 2018. u Rusiji i novu broncu na SP 2022. u Kataru postavši tako druga najmanja zemlja finalistica u povijesti svjetskih prvenstava. U temeljima ovih uspjeha nalaze se upravo igrači koji su poniknuli u Dinamovoj nogometnoj školi i(li) prošli kroz prvu momčadi plavih.

Na SP 1998. između ostalih su blistali brojni dinamovci kao Davor Šuker, Zvonimir Boban, Robert Prosinečki, Dražen Ladić, Zvonimir Soldo... Na putu do srebra u Rusiji sudjelovalo je 14 igrača koji su upravo u Dinamu proveli značajan dio svoje karijere, bilo da su tu još iz mlađih dobnih kategorija ili su afirmaciju stekli u našem kubu, a među njima i kapetan reprezentacije Luka Modrić, najbolji igrač svijeta 2018. u izboru Fife, osvajač Zlatne lopte. Uz njega se, među tih 14, nalaze i Mario Mandžukić, Dejan Lovren, Šime Vrsaljko, Marcelo Brozović, Domagoj Vida, Mateo Kovačić, Vedran Ćorluka, Milan Badelj, Andrej Kramarić, Josip Pivarić, Marko Pjaca, Tin Jedvaj i Dominik Livaković. Četiri godine kasnije uskočili su i Joško Gvardiol, Lovro Majer, Bruno Petković, Mislav Oršić, Josip Šutalo, Kristijan Jakić, Borna Barišić, Borna Sosa kao i Martin Erlić koji je kratko bio i u Dinamovoj akademiji.

Upravo je Luka Modrić, zajedno s Vedranom Ćorlukom, predvodio Dinamove juniore na premijernom izdanju Memorijala Mladen Ramljak u lipnju 2003. godine. Na otvaranju grupne faze natjecanja pobijedio ih je Osijek, ali plavi su se ubrzo oporavili, u nastavku natjecanja svladali ukrajinsku U-19 reprezentaciju i mađarski Ferencvaros da bi naslov osvojili pobjedom u finalnom dvoboju protiv turskog Galatasaray.



In the modern history of the Croatian national football team, starting from the country's independence in 1991, Croatia missed only two out of 13 World Cup and European Championship final tournaments. The magnificent performances led Croatia to the glorious record and historical success of reaching third place in 1998 World Cup in France and winning the silver medal in the 2018 WC finals in Russia. Croatia has thus become the second smallest nation by population ever to reach the World Cup final, behind Uruguay. For such a small country, a remarkable number of world class players have emerged and most of them came through GNK Dinamo Zagreb and its youth academy.

The 1998 World Cup stars include former GNK Dinamo players Davor Šuker, Zvonimir Boban, Robert Prosinečki, Dražen Ladić, Zvonimir Soldo and many others. In the 2018 World Cup there were 14 players who played for GNK Dinamo during their career including national team captain, FIFA Player of the World and Ballon d'Or winner Luka Modrić who came through our club's youth academy. Among those 14 are Luka Modrić, Mario Mandžukić, Dejan Lovren, Šime Vrsaljko, Marcelo Brozović, Domagoj Vida, Mateo Kovačić, Vedran Ćorluka, Milan Badelj, Andrej Kramarić, Josip Pivarić, Marko Pjaca, Tin Jedvaj and Dominik Livaković. Four years later they were joined by Joško Gvardiol, Lovro Majer, Bruno Petković, Mislav Oršić, Josip Šutalo, Kristijan Jakić, Borna Barišić, Borna Sosa and Martin Erlić who had short stint at Dinamo Academy.

It was Luka Modrić alongside Vedran Ćorluka who led GNK Dinamo through the very first Mladen Ramljak Tournament back in 2003. In the opening group stage game they were defeated by Croatian side Osijek but soon managed to recover and beat Ukrainian U-19 National Team and Ferencvaros from Hungary. GNK Dinamo reached the trophy by defeating the Turkish side Galatasaray in the finals.



GNK Dinamo ponosan je na sad već veliku tradiciju Međunarodnog juniorskog turnira Mladen Ramljak koji će u ljeto 2023. godine obilježiti jubilarno, 20. izdanje. Premijerni je turnir održan 2003. i u međuvremenu je preskočio samo jednu sezonu, i to uslijed globalne pandemije koronavirusa.

U jubilarnom je izdanju turnira zanimljivo zaviriti u brojke koje otkrivaju snagu, značaj pa i samu kvalitetu natjecanja promovirajući ga u jedan od prestižnih turnira u mlađim uzrastima u svijetu.

U svih 20 izdanja od 2003. godine, uključujući i ovogodišnji jubilarni turnir, nastupilo je čak 75 različitih klubova ili reprezentacija, i to iz 34 zemlje s 5 kontinenata.

U tom je razdoblju sudjelovalo čak 10 klupskih kontinentalnih prvaka od kojih šest osvajača UEFA Kupa/Lige prvaka (Real Madrid, Benfica, Manchester United, Feyenoord, Steaua, Porto), dva pobjednika znamenitog natjecanja Copa Libertadores u Južnoj Americi (Atletico Mineiro i Flamengo) kao i dva osvajača azijske Lige prvaka (Maccabi Tel Aviv kao raniji član azijske konfederacije i Ulsan Hyundai).

Na turniru je ujedno nastupilo 15 različitih klubova iz pet najjačih europskih nacionalnih liga.

Prvo izdanje Ramljakova turnira održano je 2003. godine, a Dinamo su tada predvodile dvije kasnije legende hrvatskog nogometa - Luka Modrić i Vedran Ćorluka.

Štoviše, kroz turnir je prošlo 13 igrača koji su u dresu hrvatske reprezentacije osvojili srebrnu medalju na Svjetskom prvenstvu 2018. godine u Rusiji pri čemu su Dinamov dres, nakon Modrića i Ćorluke, nosili i Milan Badelj, Dejan Lovren, Josip Pivarić, Šime Vrsaljko, Andrej Kramarić, Mateo Kovačić, Tin Jedvaj.

Kontinuitet kvalitete turnira vidljiv je i na aktualnom primjeru nove mlade zvijezde svjetskog nogometa. Najbolji igrač turnira 2021. godine bio je turski vezist Arda Güler, koji je nastupao za Fenerbahçe. Güler je ovoga ljeta u velikom transferu prešao u Real Madrid.



GNK Dinamo is proud of the already significant tradition of the International U-19 Tournament Mladen Ramljak, which will celebrate its 20th edition in the summer of 2023. The inaugural tournament took place in 2003 and has only skipped one season, due to the global coronavirus pandemic.

In this anniversary edition of the tournament, it is interesting to take a look at the numbers that reveal the strength, importance, and overall quality of the competition, promoting it as one of the prestigious youth tournaments in the world.

Throughout all 20 editions since 2003, including this year's tournament, there were 75 different clubs or national teams from 34 countries across 5 continents. During this period, there were 10 clubs that won most prestigious continental competitions, including six UEFA Cup/Champions League winners (Real Madrid, Benfica, Manchester United, Feyenoord, Steaua, Porto), two Copa Libertadores winners (Atletico Mineiro and Flamengo), and two winners of the Asian Champions League (Maccabi Tel Aviv as a previous member of the Asian Football Confederation and Ulsan Hyundai).

Furthermore, the tournament has seen the participation of 15 different clubs from the top five European national leagues.

The first edition of the Ramljak tournament was held in 2003, and at that time, it was led by two future legends of Croatian football - Luka Modrić and Vedran Ćorluka.

Moreover, the tournament has seen 13 players who later won the silver medal with the Croatian national team at the 2018 FIFA World Cup in Russia. Apart from Modrić and Ćorluka, players like Milan Badelj, Dejan Lovren, Josip Pivarić, Šime Vrsaljko, Andrej Kramarić, Mateo Kovačić, and Tin Jedvaj wore Dinamo's jersey at the Tournament.

The continuity of the Tournament's quality is also evident in the recent example of a new young star in world football. The best player of the 2021 edition of the Tournament was the Turkish midfielder Arda Güler, who played for Fenerbahçe. Güler made a big transfer move to Real Madrid this summer.

Tereni akademije GNK Dinamo dobili nazive „Luka Modrić“ i „Zlatko Kranjčar“

The matches of the 20th edition of the Memorial U-19 Tournament Mladen Ramljak will be played at the Maksimir Stadium on the pitches where Dinamo's youth teams compete. Recently, two of these pitches have been named in honor of two celebrated players who emerged from GNK Dinamo Academy.

In the survey among the fans, the owners of \$DZG fan tokens through the scoios.com platform, the football pitches have been named "Zlatko Cico Kranjčar" and "Luka Modrić."

The idea was to pay a special tribute to the players who originated from the GNK Dinamo Academy and brought glory to the Club and Croatian football.



Luka Modrić

Maksimirski “fantasista”, vođa, kapetan i mastermind Dinamove igre, Luka Modrić, odrastao je na ovim terenima i vinuo se u nogometnu orbitu postavši – najbolji igrač svijeta. Osvajač Zlatne lopte i nagrade Best FIFA Men’s Player za 2018. godinu stasao je upravo kroz Dinamovu akademiju. U reprezentaciji je debitirao kao igrač maksimirskog kluba, a kasnije u kapetanskoj ulozi poveo nacionalnu momčad u najbolje razdoblje u povijesti hrvatskog nogometa osvojivši srebro na SP 2018. i broncu na SP 2022. Bio je generator Dinamove momčadi koja je atraktivnom igrom za nogometne sladokusce pokrenula maestralan rezultatski niz i rušila brojne rekorde. Glavni je kreator renesanse kojom je povukao Dinamo do tri uzastopna naslova prvaka, od čega dvije dvostruke krune uz jedan Superkup, i tako stvorio temelje na kojima je klub i kasnije nastavio nizati rekordne serije trofeja.

Croatian “fantasista”, the leader, the captain and the mastermind of GNK Dinamo Zagreb, Luka Modrić, grew up at these training grounds and rose to the football orbit to become the – world’s best player. The 2018 Ballon d’Or winner and the Best FIFA Men’s Player of the year has been brought up through the GNK Dinamo Zagreb Academy. He made his debut for Croatia during his spell with GNK Dinamo and went on to become the national team’s captain leading it into the glory days of Croatian football by reaching the 2018 World Cup final and 2022 World Cup third-place finish. He was an architect of the GNK Dinamo team that played magnificent “football for gourmets” and started the stunning winning streak breaking numerous records. He was the creator of the Zagreb club’s renaissance leading the team to three consecutive Croatian national league titles, winning two domestic doubles and one Croatian Supercup title, thus building the platform on which GNK Dinamo continued its impressive run.

Zlatko Cico Kranjčar

Dinamova legenda i u igračkoj, ali i u trenerskoj karijeri. Personifikacija purgerskoga Dinama, jedan od kreatora furiozne momčadi koja je atraktivnim izvedbama osvojila naslov prvaka 1982. Igrač poteza, vica, sjajan tehničar, silovit i nadahnut i kao napadač, ali i polušpica. Rođen je 15. 11. 1956. u Zagrebu, a u Maksimiru je bio od svoje devete godine i povezao gotovo dva desetljeća. Za sebe je govorio da je s Dinamom kao igrač, uz dva Kupa, osvojio dva naslova prvaka: onaj iz 1982., ali i tri godine ranije kad je sudskom odlukom plavima pripao pokal za 1979. Bio je kapetan u prvoj utakmici hrvatske reprezentacije u modernoj povijesti. U trenerskoj je ulozi dvaput uveo Dinamo u Ligu prvaka, a u tri trenerska mandata osvojio pet trofeja. Naš nezaboravni Cico preminuo je 1. 3. 2021. u Zagrebu.

A club legend both as player and coach. A boy from Zagreb, a kind of personification of “Purger’s” Dinamo from 1982 when he was among the key players who were driving force of a magnificent team that performed creative and beautiful football that led them to the national championship title. A player with great technical skills, powerful and inspired both as a striker and an offensive midfielder. He was born on November 11, 1956 in Zagreb, came to Dinamo as a 9 year old boy and stayed for almost two decades. He liked to indicate that, in addition to the two Cup titles, he reached two national championship crowns with Dinamo: in 1982 and in 1979 when the title was awarded to Dinamo by the decision of a Court. He was a first captain in the modern history of the Croatian national team. He was in the coaching role for three terms in Dinamo winning five trophies. He is remembered as a first coach to introduce Dinamo to the UEFA Champions League twice. Our beloved Cico passed away on March 1, 2021.

1. GNK Dinamo je organizator međunarodnog memorijalnog turnira "MLADEN RAMLJAK 2023"
2. Turnir traje od 03. - 06.08.2023. godine.
3. Na turniru sudjeluje osam (8) klubova. Natjecanje će se odvijati u dvije skupine po četiri kluba.
4. Na osnovu bodovanja jednostrukim bod sistemom (pobjeda - 3 boda; neriješeno - 1 bod) dobiva se pobjednik skupine. Ukoliko dvije (2) momčadi imaju jednak broj bodova o pobjedniku odlučuje:
 - a) razlika postignutih i primljenih zgoditaka
 - b) međusobni susret
 - c) broj postignutih zgoditaka
 - d) bacanje novčića
5. Za prvo mjesto na turniru igraju dvije (2) prvoplasirane momčadi po skupinama. Na isti način utvrđuje se i plasman od trećeg do osmog mjesta.
6. Ukoliko utakmica razigravanja za plasman, nakon isteka regularnog vremena završi neriješeno, pristupa se izvođenju jedanesteraca.

1. CFC Dinamo is the organiser of the International Memorial Tournament “Mladen Ramljak 2023”
2. The Tournament will be played in the period from 3 rd - 6 th August 2023
3. Eight clubs will participate at the Tournament. The clubs will be divided in two groups of four teams.
4. The winners of the groups will be decided on the basis of a single point system (three points for a win, one point for a draw and zero points for a defeat). If, on completion of the group matches, two teams have an equal number of points, the winner will be decided according to the following criteria:
 - a) Difference between scored and received goals
 - b) Head-to-head match result
 - c) Number of scored goals
 - d) Coin toss
5. Two group winners will play the match for the first place. The ranking for the 3rd until the 8th place will be determined in the same way.
6. If the play-off matches end in a draw after the end of the regular playing time, penalty kicks shall be taken to determine the winner.
7. Players born on January 1st 2005 and younger are eligible to play at the Tournament. All players who participate at the Tournament must be properly registered with their respective football associations with maximum of six guest players. Verification of identity of home teams players shall be made on the basis of the club registrations, and the identity of foreignteams players on the basis of their passports.
8. Each club taking part in the Tournament may register twenty players per match. A total of 22 players can be registered for the tournament, at least two of which must be goalkeepers. 20 players can be entered for each match. During the match, the substitution of all players is possible, but in the second half only three (3) breaks of play to perform the substitutions are allowed (multiple players can be substituted in one break).
9. Each match lasts 2 x 40 minutes, without extra time. Placement matches for 3 rd till 8 th place last 2 x 30 minutes.
10. The Croatian Football Federation will appoint referees for all matches.
11. A player who receives 2 yellow cards is suspended for the next match. The same applies for a player who is sent off the field of play. For a serious offence, a player who is sent off may be severely punished. Such decision will be made by Disciplinary referee appointed by Tournament Committee.
12. The organiser shall set up a Tournament Committee, which shall be responsible for all sporting arrangements in connection with the tournament, as well as for any disputes, protests, complains or unforeseen circumstances. This Tournament Committee will be composed of the following persons:

13. In the event of any case not foreseen by these Regulations, the Tournament Committee is empowered to make interpretations, which will be considered as amendments to these Regulations.
14. All protests or complaints shall be made to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final and binding. The Committee will not accept complaints relating to decisions taken by the referee.
15. The Tournament organiser is not liable for eventual accidents of players during a match. Clubs are obliged to provide an insurance coverage for players against any injuries and accidents. The organiser does not bear any expenses resulted by medical treatment of players.
16. The matches will be played in accordance with Laws of the Game.

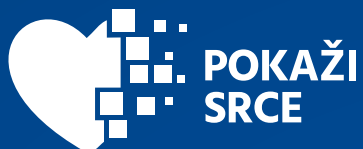
