Why Did god require a sacrifice?

- 1. To satisfy his justice
- 2. To express his love

b. The Glory Applied: Sacrifice for others reflect Jesus

3. The Glory of the Crown

v.9 "God has highly exalted Him" What does exaltation reference?

1. Christ's resurrection (v.9a)
2. Christ's Honor (v.9b)
3. Christ's Authority (v. 10-11)
