## MoU Italy with Panama, Ghana and Papua New Guinea PANAMA Activity 2 – National Forest Reference Level Task 3 – Demonstration

The aim of Activity 2 is the development of the National Forest Reference Level (NFRL) and its submission to the UNFCCC. The submission of the NFRL is one the key requirements under the UNFCCC for countries to be able to receive results-based payments as agreed in several COP decisions. The NFRL will be developed consistent with all relevant UNFCCC decisions and IPCC Good Practice Guidance and guidelines and in the context of national development objectives. The submission of the NFRL to the REDD+ Info Hub on the UNFCCC REDD+ Web Platform will comply with existing international guidance on REDD+.

One of the tasks under Activity 2 is Demonstration. The main objective of this task will be to undertake a stakeholders consultation with the view to discuss methods for estimating the draft national forest reference level, implementation rules and procedures, implications for various stakeholder groups and development.

## Term: 90 days

The Demonstration is based on the following sub actions:

- 1) Preparation of presentations of the draft NFRL and explanatory documentation
- 2) Preparation of dissemination material
- 3) Organization of workshop and field visits with the view to collect stakeholders' views on the draft NFRL

## Methodology

- Preparation of material for stakeholders consultations (15 days)
- Organisation of workshops and field visits (75 days): visits and workshops will be conducted in the whole country with the view to cover all relevant stakeholders and collect comments and views on the draft NFRL and its policy implications
