Step 2: After you could have downloaded the software program and ran it, and changed the ELUA to true, you wish to go to logmein.com to obtain Hamachi, a internet hosting company. It is free. Dowload Unmanaged. Make sure to create an account if you don't have one.

Step 3: Once you have downloaded and put in Hamachi and the Minecraft server platform, go ahead and run Hamachi, and log in. After that, click on "Create New Community," and fill in the following fields.

Step 4: After that, it's best to see an IP that does not begin with 192.168 or 127.0.0.0. Right click the IP and make sure you select "Copy IPv4 Handle," not IPv6.

Step 5: Go into the "server.txt" file that came along with your server file. Open it in a text editor utility, equivalent to Notepad++ or Windows Notepad. Change "server-ip:" to your copied IPv4 Address. You possibly can paste by right clicking or doing CTRL+V. Ensure that there are no Areas.

Step 6: Now, with the Minecraft Server file open and working, now you can shut Hamachi. Do not shut the tray icon though. look at me never rat on your friends and always keep your mouth shut and type the IPv4 Tackle into the server info.
