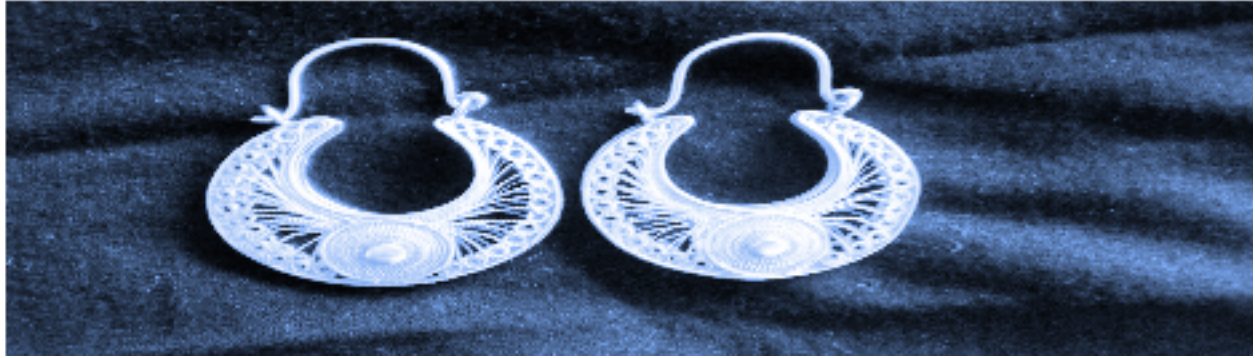
## **Local Handicrafts :**
