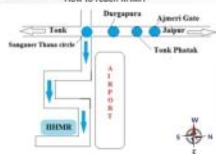

#### Emerging Careers in Pharmaceutical Industry

(Clinical Research, Pharmacovigilance, and Data Management)

##### Clinical Research (CR)

Many foreign pharmaceutical companies, biotechnology, and contract research organizations are expanding their business in Indian shores due to 50-50% cost saving associated with conducting clinical trials in India. It is a growing industry and it allows an exciting career path along with accelerated growth prospective to pharma /science /biotech/ medical students. Students can start their career as a clinical research associate with good remuneration and may acquire the position of Vice-President/Director after 8-10 years with estimated CTC of 8-20 Lakhs per annum in different capacities depending upon the student's skills and experience.

##### Pharmacovigilance (PV)

PV has been expanding in recent years, as companies are required to monitor the drug safety post launch. In last five years, there is an exponentially growth in placement of pharma graduates and post graduates. Presently, the important growing pharma sector is biologicals/biosimilars market and CDSCO already drafted the guideline on post marketing surveillance specifically to market the biosimilars. Many pharmaceutical companies (MNCs & Indian), Biotech Companies Regulatory agencies, CROs, KPOs, PV units in medical colleges have options for trained and profession PV experts. It is a lucrative career where one can earn from five to fifteen lakhs per annum.

##### Clinical Data Management (CDM)

Scope in CDM is quite vast for the candidates who are much interested in data analysis and data management. It is the process of entry, verification, validation, and quality control of the data gathered during the clinical conductance. CDM is a critical phase of clinical development, which leads to generate the high-quality, reliable, protocol compliant, and statistically sound data to meet the regulatory needs for the product approval. It is a lucrative option for pharma scholars and students can be hired as clinical managers, database administrator, database programmer with good remuneration as per the best in industry.
