
GOD'S PERFECT SIGINS

GOD'S PERFECT SIGNS IN THE SKY

As we know during 2014-2015 there would be signs seen in the sky, namely:

A Greek statistician named Paul Grevas has studied the "Biblic Blood Moon Tetrad", which is 4 total lunar eclipses that occur consecutively in the first year, 2 total lunar eclipses are to happen on the day of the Passover and at the Feast of Tabernacles, then similar events happen in the following year.

In his investigation, Paul Grevas used documents from NASA where data of the lunar and solar eclipses in the span of 6,000 years, from 3000 BC till 3000 AD, are kept safe.

Statistically, the probability that the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad would occur is one in $1.85 \times (10)^{139}$ or 1.85×1 with 139 zeros. For comparison, 1 million is $(10)^6 = 1,000,000,1$ billion is $(10)^9 = 1,000,000,000$ and 1 trillion is $(10)^{12} = 1,000,000,000,000$. Now, if the probability of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad to occur is one in $1.85 \times (10)^{139}$, the possibility of this to happen is considered very very small and can be ignored. So when the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad happens, that certainly can not happen by pure chance. The assessment of this probability does not include

the possibility of adding to the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad the solar eclipse that may happen on other feast days of the Israelites. As what would happen during 2014-2015, besides the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad there would be also two solar eclipses on other feast days of the Israelites.

Paul Grevas investigated that the next Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad would happen again during 2582-2583 or about 570 years from now.


When we look at the condition of the world today, whereas

Since 3,000 years before Christ until today the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad had occurred 7 times. And very interestingly, every time it occured it was always connected with some big event regarding the Israel.


The first Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad was preceded by an extraordinary natural phenomenon which occured at the time of the crucifixion of the Lord Jesus.



Graphic A: There were 4 lunar eclipses in the year 32 and 33 AD: Two total lunar eclipses and two partial lunar eclipses. Two other total lunar eclipses occurred before (28-29AD) and another two after (36 AD) those 4 lunar eclipses. In addition, there was also a total solar eclipse on the day of Passover in the year 33 AD.

These signs in the sky were connected with the crucifixion of the Lord Jesus that occurred on the day of Passover in the year 33 AD.

- There were 2 total lunar eclipses in the year 32 AD and 2 partial lunar eclipses in the year 33 AD.
- In the year 32 AD the moon looked like blood (blood moon) on the day of Passover and at the Feast of Tabernacles.
- In the year 33 AD there was a partial lunar eclipse on the day of Passover and another one at the Feast of Tabernacles.
- On April 3, 33 AD, exactly on the day of Passover, a total solar eclipse (total darkness) happened according to Lk 23: 44-45 "And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour. And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst."
- Only 2 total lunar eclipses occurred before and another 2 after the tetrad lunar eclipses.
- No four partial solar eclipses occurred before nor after the tetrad lunar eclipses.




Graphic 1: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 162-163 AD. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.

In the year when those signs in the sky occurred the people of Israel dispersed to the Continent (Europe), because of the persecution by the Roman emperor Marcus Aurelius Antoninus.

Compared with the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015 (Graphic 8 A):


- There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad .
- There were 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on January 7, 163 AD, the interval from the third total lunar eclipse to the midpoint is 29 years, while the interval from the fourth total lunar eclipse to the midpoint is 17 years.



Graphic 2: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 795-796 AD. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and 3 others thereafter.

In the year when those signs in the sky occurred, the Caliph of Islam made war to take possession over the European countries but was defeated by King Charlemagne. In this battle millions of Christians and Jews were killed.


- There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- No four partial solar eclipses were detected before nor after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on December 30, 795 AD, the interval from the third total lunar eclipse to the midpoint is 3 years, while the interval from the fourth total lunar eclipse to the midpoint is 6,5 years.



Graphic 3: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 842-843 AD. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 thereafter. There were also 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 thereafter.

At the time those signs in the sky occurred, the Roman Empire collapsed as the Moslem country succeeded in taking control of the Byzantine, and in that warfare millions of Christians and Jews were killed.

- There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- There were 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on December 20, 842 AD, the interval from the fourth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 3 years, while the interval from the fifth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 6 years.




Graphic 4: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 860-861 AD. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 thereafter. There were also 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 thereafter.

At the time those signs in the sky occurred, the Moslem Empire tried to gain dominion over the world but was defeated by the European countries. In the event millions of Christians and Jews were killed.

Compared with the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015 (Graphic 8 A):

 There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.

- There were 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on December 31, 860 AD, the interval from the fourth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 3 years, while the interval from the fifth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 8 years.




Graphic 5: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 1493-1494. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad and another 3 thereafter. There were also 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 thereafter.

At the time those signs in the sky occurred, Columbus anchored at the American continent for the second time, and that was the beginning of the colonization of the American continent.

- There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- There were 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.

• If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on December 29, 1493 AD, the interval from the fourth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 14 years, while the interval from the fifth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 3 years.




Graphic 6: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 1949-1950. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 thereafter. There were also 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 thereafter. There was also a total solar eclipse at the Feast of Trumpets.

At the time those signs in the sky occurred, the independence of the State of Israel gained recognition from the United Nations.

- There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- There were 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- A total solar eclipse occurred at the Feast of Trumpets.


• If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on January 4, 1950 AD, the interval from the fourth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 3 years, while the interval from the fifth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 14 years.



Graphic 7: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 1967-1968. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 thereafter. There were also 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 thereafter.

At the time those signs in the sky occurred, the Israelites gained dominion over East Jerusalem as the result of the 6-days war.

- There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and another 3 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- There were 4 partial solar eclipses before and another 4 after the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad.
- If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which falls on January 4, 1950, the interval from the fourth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 3 years, while the interval from the fifth partial solar eclipse to the midpoint is 14 years.




Graphic 8 A: Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015. There were 3 total lunar eclipses before and there will be another 3 thereafter. There were also 4 partial solar eclipses before and there will be another 4 thereafter.

- If we take the midpoint of the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad which will fall on January 5, 2015, the interval from the first total lunar eclipse to the midpoint is exactly the same as from the fourth total lunar eclipse to the midpoint (266 days). Also from the second or the third lunar eclipse to the midpoint (90 days). There is no difference at all, not even 1 day.
- Similarly, the 3 total lunar eclipses that occurred before that Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad. Each had the same interval as the coming one paired with it, when calculated from the day of its occurrence to the midpoint. (Check the first and the sixth; the second and the fifth; the third and the fourth.)
- This is also true with the 4 partial solar eclipses that occurred before the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad . Each had the same interval as the expected one

- paired with it, when calculated from the day of its occurrence to the midpoint.
- The second total lunar eclipse on June 15, 2011 was seen in Jerusalem as well as the coming one paired with it, namely the fifth total lunar eclipse, which would be seen there on July 27, 2018.
- The last blood moon in the year 2015 that would happen at the Feast of Tabernacles is to become a Supermoon. It would look larger and could be seen in Jerusalem.

All lunar and the solar eclipses, either total or partial, which are related to the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015, are shown below:



NOTE:

There were 3 total solar eclipses occurred before the total lunar eclipse (blood moon) on December 21, 2010. All three of them were seen on the first day of Av (the fifth month of the Israelite calendar), namely

- Total solar eclipse on the 1st day of Av, 2008
- Total solar eclipse on the 1st day of Av, 2009
- Total solar eclipse on the 1st day of Av, 2010

If we observe how the solar eclipses and the total lunar eclipses during 2014-2015 and also other eclipses before or thereafter occurred in such orderly and

symmetrical sequence, then surely they could not happen accidentally. Why? Because unlike a shooting star or a falling star that can happen at any time, a solar eclipse or a lunar eclipse occurs not haphazardly but following the DEFINITE natural law and order based on the rotation of the sun, moon and earth. That's why NASA scientists and experts can compute correctly when an eclipse is to happen, because the rotations of the three celestial bodies in the solar system are definite. Accordingly, the Israelite festivals are definite too following the Jewish calendar, where the date of each feast day is fixed. Hence the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015 and the accompanying eclipses definitely happened because a tremendous power control them. Since statistically the probability that a Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad may occur is 1 in 1.85 x $(10)^{139}$, we can imagine how small the chance is for the symmetrical eclipses to happen, like those accompanying the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015. I am sure that no one, however genius he might be, is capable of doing such an amazing thing, even if only to compute, moreover to set up for it to happen exactly as the Biblical Blood Moon Tetrad during 2014-2015.

Indeed it is obviously a sign from God to make us aware of at least two things:

- 1. There will be some phenomenal events related with those signs in the sky.
- 2. God revealed His power to mankind so we would be aware and understand that there is no one like God. Isaiah 40:18 "To whom, then, will you compare God? Or what image will you compare him to?"
