I have been interested in chemistry and air pollution since childhood. I became involved in improving the air of Buncombe County in 1969 when I became aware of the inversion layers and stagnant air that exist here. I first served on the Technical Advisory Committee of the WNC Regional Air Pollution Agency in the 1970's when Roy Roberts and Sam Bingham were active in the air pollution control effort. I currently serve as Chair of the Technical Advisory Committee for the WNC Regional Air Pollution Agency.

I teach in the Chemistry and Environmental Studies Departments at Warren Wilson College and have done mathematical modeling of the chemistry of photochemical smog for over ten years. Currently, I am working to set up an ozone monitoring station at Warren Wilson College.

My interest in air pollution arose because of my childhood in Southern California. At a young age I was intrigued by the technical and political problems associated with air pollution. I have a B.A. degree in Chemistry from Whittier College and a Ph.D. degree from Stanford University but have lived and worked in Buncombe County since 1969. My children were born and raised here. My wife, Lynn Shackelton Kahl, is co-owner of Asheville Speech and Language Associates. She was born and raised in Asheville and attended Reynolds High School, Lenoir-Rhyne College and Western Carolina University.

I am very concerned about air quality in Western North Carolina and have been working to improve our air quality for many years. However, I am also aware of the need to balance the costs and benefits of various air pollution strategies.
