YouTube star turned boxing sensation Jake Paul has reportedly lined up his next fight - a meeting with former UFC welterweight Ben Askren. First reported by MMA media personality Chael Sonnen, the Paul-Askren fight will reportedly take place in Los Angeles on March 28.

Celebrity boxing returns to the center stage this weekend in Atlanta. After months of build up to make this possible, YouTube star Jake Paul is set to take on former Bellator MMA and ONE Championship welterweight titleholder Ben Askren in an 8-round bout at cruiserweight. The two have traded trash talk for the better part of six months after Paul made waves with his thunderous knockout of Nate Robinson in November. Now Askren, never known as a big puncher, will step into the boxing ring for the first time since announcing his MMA retirement in 2019. Plus, this card also sees the return of a potential start at 140 pounds when Regis Prograis steps in against Ivan Redkach. And former UFC heavyweight champion Frank Mir makes his boxing debut when he faces Steve Cunningham.

Jake Paul vs Ben Askren takes place on **Saturday, April 17**.

The undercard begins at 2am UK time, with the main event at around **5am** UK time through the night into Sunday morning.

The big show will also feature musical performances by Justin Bieber, The Black Keys, Doja Cat, Saweetie, Diplo, Major Lazer and Mt. Westmore (Snoop Dogg, Ice Cube, Too \$hort and E-40).
