# Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty

·Commission Guard or USAR ·Up to 2 years (.5,1,1.5,2)

Participate in SMP (Guard or USAR)

Pays <u>full</u> tuition or R&B (10K max R&B)

·Non-revocable

Unlimited/Based on fundingMust have 2.5 GPA

·Masters students eligible

Can use any GI bill

·Be academically aligned

### **USAR/ARNG** Dedicated

- Commission to Dedicated RC
- Up to 4 years\* (.5,1,1.5,2,2.5,3,4)
  - Participate in SMP
- Pays <u>full</u> tuition or R&B (10K max R&B)
  - Non-revocable
  - Unlimited/Based on funding
    - Must have 2.5 GPA
    - Masters students eligible
- Can't use Select CH 1606/1607 (Can use Chapter 30/33 MGIB)
  - Be academically aligned

### RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

#### **MUST:**

- > All applicants must be academically aligned and medically qualified
- > All applicants must have a valid APFT and meet AR 600-9 standards
- > All applicants must be basic course qualified via BCT, CIET or MS1 & MS2 qualified
- > All must be Currently enlisted or eligible for enlistment
- > All scholarships must be actioned before the last day of the Spring semester
- > After accepting any scholarship, the Cadet must SMP and drill monthly

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- ➤ Dedicated Guard scholarship winners <u>cannot</u> use CH 1606/1607 MGIB. They <u>can</u> use CH 30 or CH 33 MGIB if eligible
- GRFD scholarship winners can use any type of MGIB
- Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) <u>cannot</u> be combined with any scholarship, however State Tuition Assistance (STA) <u>can</u> be used with any type of scholarship
- > All scholarships pay full tuition and fees or room and board up to \$10,000 per year
