Introduction

Southampton CRF has years of experience and expertise in delivering the highest standard of early phase and experimental medicine research. Our large team has grown over the years, and we are in an excellent position to host this conference for the first time since 2007.

In the spirit of collaboration, the 2022 conference will be hosted in the neighbouring town of Bournemouth, the home of some of our key research partners and a site for vaccine trials during the pandemic. Bournemouth sits on the south coast on the eastern edge of Dorset; it features amazing beaches, while still being close to the city of Southampton and the wonderful New Forest National Park.

The Bournemouth International Centre is the largest purpose-built event venue on the south coast. There are versatile and open plan reception areas, domed exhibition arena, not to mention the magnificent Art Deco Ballroom in the Pavilion Theatre building.

The conference programme reflects how collaboration across the NIHR infrastructure is key to both CRF delivery and equity of access to experimental medicine and early phase studies. The conference will explore how CRF's can use collaboration to improve research outcomes that links Biomedical Resource Centres, NHS Trusts, Universities and all of our partners, while also providing opportunities for extended learning sessions, expert plenaries, and activities such as Wellbeing and Mindfulness.





Who attends

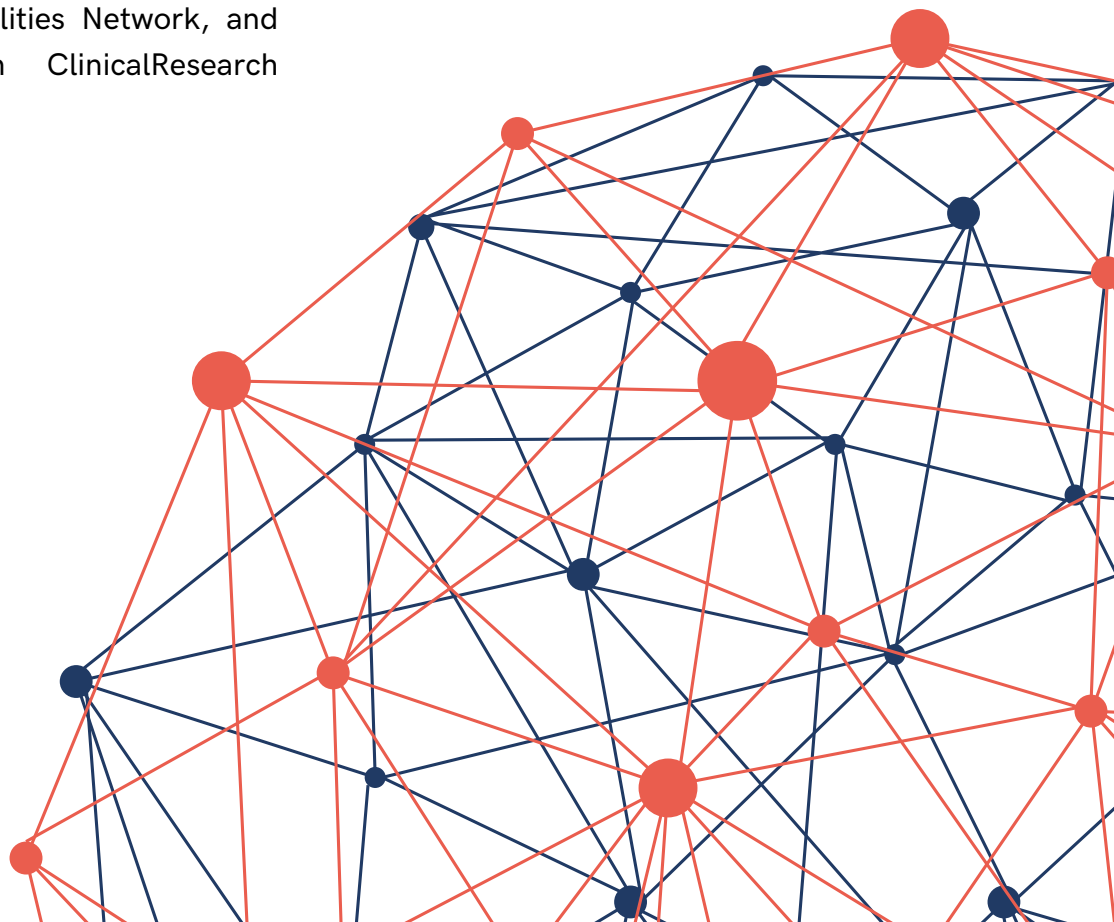
The Conference is expected to attract up to 400 delegates from across the UK's Experimental Medicine Infrastructure, including Doctors, researchers, nurses, AHPs, administrative support staff, laboratory staff and research managers. These staff are responsible for delivery of 1,000s of experimental medicine studies across the UK.
