SURVIVOR IMMUNITY IDOLS **BY SEASON**



PLAYED CORRECTLY

The idol was used on/by the contestant who received the most votes at Tribal Council, saving them from elimination | Frequency: 28/92 Example: Wentworth plays her idol at Final 12 on Cambodia and negates 9 votes.

PLAYED INCORRECTLY

The idol was used on/by a contestant who did not receive the most votes at Tribal Council, removing the idol from the game | Frequency: 36/92 Example: Spencer plays his idol at Final 8 on Cagayan and negates 0 votes.

NOT PLAYED

The contestant who received the most votes at Tribal Council had the idol but did not play it, removing them and their idol from the game | Frequency: 14/92 Example: James does not play either of his idols at Final 7 on China, receives 5 votes, and is eliminated.

EXPIRED



The contestant who had the idol never played it because of expiration at Final 5 or extenuating circumstances (e.g. medical evacuation) | Frequency: 14/92 Example: Malcolm's idol is no longer usable when he reaches the Final 4 on Philippines.

Since being introduced on Survivor: Guatemala, hidden immunity idols have become a regular fixture of the series.

This graphic charts the frequency of idols on every season since Survivor: Guatemala. Idols are arranged by season in the order they were found (inside being found earliest, outside latest), and are color-coded based on how they were played.
