

Collect Card Games Tournaments

Magic the Gathering

The Magic the Gathering tournament will adhere to the rules of play and deck construction constraints as proscribed by Wizards of the Coast.

The format for the tournament is Standard Format.

Cards may only be used from the following sets:

- Hour of Devastation
- Amonkhet
- Aether Revolt
- Kaladesh
- Eldritch Moon
- Shadows Over Innistrad
- Oath of the Gatewatch
- Battle for Zendikar

Any illegal cards found in a deck will be replaced by a basic land card. If the deck is to be found with more than 3 illegal cards, the player will be disqualified from the tournament.

The deck must be consistent with the following:

- The deck must be no less than 60 cards.
- Up to 15 cards may be included in your sideboard if a player wishes to use a side board.
- Decks must not have more than 4 copies of any individual card (other than basic land) in the main deck and side board.
- There is no maximum deck size as long as the player is able to shuffle the deck in their hands unassisted.

The tournament will be a single knockout style with pairings to be randomly generated.

Round determination: When time is called, there will be three additional turns of play, with the active turn being considered turn "zero".

Pokemon Tournament

The Pokemon TCG tournament will adhere to the rules of play and deck construction constraints as proscribed by Pokemon Organised Play, with the only modification being that the seniors and masters age group will be combined.

Pokemon decks should contain 60 cards, no more and no less. Decks should contain no more than 4 copies of any given card (excluding basic energy). Sets and promo cards legal for play can be found by following the link below. Any cards not from within these sets will be treated as basic energy.

Please note that Pokemon Organised play has banned the card Lysandre's Trump Card.

The tournament will use a Swiss format, being capped at 4 rounds. Should there be no clear winner based on winning record at this point a count-back method will be used to determine a winner.

Round length: 50 minutes

Round determination: When time is called there will be three additional turns of play, with the active turn being considered turn 'zero'

A player must take all prize cards to win, remaining prizes is no longer used by Pokemon Organised Play to determine match winners.

In the case of incomplete rounds, the player with the most wins for the round will be declared the winner, if both players are tied for wins in the round the round will be declared a tie.

Yu Gi OhYu Gi Oh! Tournament Rules

- 5 swiss rounds, 20 minutes each with time procedure (current turn + 5 additional turns, higher life points at end wins that game)
- Any games still going 10min after time is called end immediately
- If theres more than 1 undefeated or we have time for top cut (the above should take about 3hr 20min) we'll do some sort of playoff
