Instructions given for 46 cm. (18 inch) Chest, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS AND MEASUREMENTS

2 - 3¾ mm. (No. 9), 2 - 3¼ mm. (No. 10) and 2 - 4 mm. (No. 8) Aero Knitting Needles. 3 Buttons for Jacket and 1 for Bonnet. Stitch Holder.					
Length from Back of Neck.	21.5 8½	24 9½	26.5 10½	cm. ins.	
Sleeve Seam.	9 3½	11.5 4½	14 5½	cm. ins.	

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

K. - Knit; P. - Purl; st(s). - stitch(es); g.st. - garter stitch; tog. - together; rept. - repeat; beg. - beginning; inc. - increase; dec. - decrease; y.fwd. - yarn forward; sl.1. - slip one; p.s.s.o. - pass slip stitch over; patt. - pattern; 0 - No sts. or rows to be worked in that particular size; cm. - centimetres; ins. - inches.

Success will be assured if you . . .

Use ONLY the Wendy or Peter Pan yarn specified. (We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used.)

Follow our instructions exactly, make certain you have the right tension. Measure (without stretching) to see you're knitting the right number of stitches as stated. Too many?—use larger needles. Too few?—use finer needles. Once the tension is right, the size will be right.

TENSION: 11 sts. and 16 rows to 5 cm. (2 ins.) over lacy stitch on 4 mm. (No. 8) Needles.

MATINEE COAT

BACK

Using 4 mm. (No. 8) Needles, cast on 62 (68) (74) sts.
Knit 5 Rows.

Commence Patt.

1st Row - K.1, * K.3, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., rept. from * to last st. K.1.

2nd Row - Purl.

3rd Row - K.1, * y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K.3, rept. from * to last st., K.1.

4th Row - Purl.

These 4 rows form the patt.

Rept. the last 4 rows 9 (10) (11) times more.
Inc. 1 st. at end of last row.

Change to 3¾ mm (No. 9) Needles.

Shape Sleeves

Next Row – Cast on 18 (24) (30) sts. K.1, * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

Next Row – Cast on 18 (24) (30) sts. P.1, * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end. 99 (117) (135) sts.

Next Row – K.1, * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

Next Row – P.1, * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end. Rept. the last 2 rows 9 (10) (11) times more.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 39 (47) (55) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Sl. remaining 21 (23) (25) sts. onto a st. holder. Break off yarn.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4 mm. (No. 8) Needles, cast on 33 (36) (39) sts.

Knit 5 Rows.

Commence Patt. with Front Band.

1st Row – K.1, * K.3, y.fwd., sl.1., K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., rept. from * to last 8 (5) (8) sts., K. to end.

2nd Row – K.4, P. to end.

3rd Row – K.1, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., *K.3, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., rept. from * to last 5 (8) (5) sts., K. to end.

4th Row – As 2nd Row.

These 4 rows form the patt. and g.st. front band.

Rept. the last 4 rows 9 (10) (11) times more.

Change to 3¾ mm. (No. 9) Needles.

Shape Sleeve

Next Row – Cast on 18 (24) (30) sts. * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to last 5 (4) (5) sts., K. to end.

Next Row – K.4 (5) (4) * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to last st., P.1.

Next Row – * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to last 5 (4) (5) sts., K. to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows 5 (6) (7) times more.

** Shape Neck

Next Row – K.4, rib 5 (5) (6), sl. these sts. onto a safety pin, rib to end.

Continue in rib, dec. 1 st. at neck edge on every row until 39 (47) (55) sts. remain. Continue without further dec. until Front measures same as Back to shoulder finishing at sleeve edge. Cast off. **

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4 mm. (No. 8) Needles, cast on 33 (36) (39) sts.

Knit 5 Rows.

Commence Patt. with Front Band

1st Row – K.5, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., * K.3, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., rept. from * to last 1 (4) (1) sts., K. to end.

2nd Row – P. to last 4 sts., K.4.

3rd Row – K.5, * K.3, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., rept. from * to last 4 (1) (4) sts., K. to end.

4th Row – As 2nd Row.

These 4 rows form the patt. and g.st. front band.

Rept. the last 4 rows 9 (10) (11) times more.

Change to 3¾ mm. (No. 9) Needles.

Next Row (Buttonhole Row) – K.2, y.fwd., K.2 tog., K.1 (0) (1), * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

Shape Sleeve

Next Row – Cast on 18 (24) (30) sts. P.1, * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to last 4 (5) (4) sts., K. to end.

Continue in rib with 4 sts. in g.st. for front band, work 12 (14) (16) rows working buttonhole as before on the 7th (7th) (9th) row.

Work from ** to ** of Left Front.

BONNET

Using 4 mm (No. 8) Needles, cast on 61 (67) (73) sts.

1st Row – K.1, * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

2nd Row – P.1, * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows 3 times more, inc. 1 st. at end of last row.

Change to patt.

Work 5 (6) (7) complete patts. as given for Back.

Keeping patt. correct, cast off 12 (13) (14) sts. at beg. of next 4 rows.

Continue on the centre 14 (16) (18) sts.

Change to g.st. (every row knit).

K.2 tog. at each end of the needle on the 19th and following 10th row. 10 (12) (14) sts.

Continue in g.st. until 30 (34) (38) rows in g.st. have been worked.

Leave sts. on needle. Break off yarn.

PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given. Press as instructions.

MAKING UP

MATINEE COAT

Join shoulder and top sleeve seams by back-stitching.

Neckband

With right side facing sl. 4 sts. from safety pin onto a 3¼ mm. (No. 10) Needle, K. remaining 5 (5) (6) sts. from safety pin, pick up and K. 7 sts. up right front neck, K. 21 (23) (25) sts. from back neck, pick up and K. 7 sts. down left front neck, K. 9 (9) (10) sts. from safety pin. 53 (55) (59) sts.

Knit 1 Row.

Next Row (Buttonhole Row) – K.2, y.fwd., K.2 tog., K. to end.

Work 6 rows g.st. Cast off.

Cuffs (Both Alike)

With right side facing, using 3¼ mm. (No. 10) Needles, pick up and K. 31 (35) (39) sts. evenly on sleeve edge.

Work 6 rows g.st. Cast off.

Join seams by backstitching.

Sew on buttons.

BONNET

Join seams by backstitching.

Neckband

With right side facing, using 3¼ mm. (No. 10) Needles, pick up and K. 17 (21) (25) sts. on left neck edge, K. 10 (12) (14) sts. from back neck, pick up and K. 18 (22) (26) sts. from right neck edge. 45 (55) (65) sts.

Commencing on a 2nd row, work 5 rows in rib as given for face edge of bonnet.

Cast off in rib.

Chin Strap

Using 3¼ mm. (No. 10) Needles, cast on 27 (31) (35) sts.

Work 3 rows g.st.



Next Row (Buttonhole Row) – K.2, y.fwd., K.2 tog., K. to end.

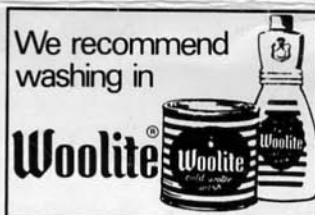
Work 3 rows g.st. Cast off.

Sew to neckband.

Sew on button.

Press seams.
