

Minecraft Windows Q0 Edition Headed To Oculus Rift VR Headset

Palmer Luckey, the boy genius co-founder of Oculus VR was astonished by those who attended the company's Connect 2 developer conference today with the announcement that Minecraft is coming to the Rift. urbanislover Though Oculus has yet to announce a launch date for its virtual reality headset, it's expected to go on sale by the end of spring, at which point Minecraft will be made available on both the Windows Store and Oculus Store. It's not surprising that Microsoft will bring the hugely popular crafting game to the Rift platform, as it has recently demoed several augmented reality versions for its HoloLens headset, and has pledged to support both Oculus and Vive's versions of VR.
