Usage

1. Proper-click on a .jar file.
2. Hover over "Open with".
3. Click on on "Choose one other app".
4. Tick the box saying "All the time use this app to open .jar information".
5. Click on "Extra apps".
6. Scroll to the underside of the record.
7. Click on "Look for another app on this Pc".
8. Now browse to the situation the place you put in this script. Minecraftservers By default it is named "MinecraftJarInstaller.exe".
9. Select it and click on on "Open" (or double-click the file).
10. Now you may get an error saying "You could set this program as default." Ignore it and click okay.
11. Now open any .jar file from within file explorer and it ought to work.

Changing THE JAVA EXECUTABLE PATH

The default path for the Java executable bundled with minecraft is "C:\Program Recordsdata (x86)\Minecraft Launcher\runtime\java-runtime-alpha\home windows-x64\java-runtime-alpha\bin\java.exe".

Your Java executable may be positioned someplace else, if you probably did a customized install. In that case you would need to seek out and enter the correct path.

Do the next:

1. Browse to the location the place you installed this script. By default it is named "MinecraftJarInstaller.exe".
