St Oswalds Charitable giving We have a new church, but how are we following Jesus' lead on providing for the hungry, persecuted, the lame and our brothers and sisters locally? The PCC agreed to follow the following idea. We are going to use a collection box to collect;

- Donations from the congregation
- Some money from collection plate; after the money has been banked
- Donations from other events i.e. Natter etc when possible

The money collected in April and May will go to provide support for persecuted Christians

- June, July, August - Money goes to a medical charity
- September/October/November - money goes towards something in the community i.e. Bridget's hampers or lunch for older people or the lonely.
- December, January & February will go to the Foodbank at Rossington

These may change very year with exception of the Foodbank and the community one. Thanks Margaret Liddle

Notice For Finningley Church Family:

You may have heard that we are changing our Gift Aid collection to a scheme run by the Church of England called the Parish Giving Scheme.

If you give to the church by standing order/direct debit I would ask you to consider changing to the new scheme. This means that we will get the Gift Aid money from HMRC every month instead of quarterly as before. This will help our cash flow massively.

If you give by envelope, and would prefer to change to direct debit, you can join the scheme.

If you are a taxpayer you can join the scheme.

If you are a non taxpayer you can join the scheme.

ANYONE who gives regularly in church can join the scheme.

I have a pack for anyone who is interested with all the information you will need. Of course there may be some who cannot pay by direct debit or prefer to leave it the way it is now. That is fine, there is no requirement to change what you do now but we would encourage everyone to look at this scheme. Just think, no more searching for money every weekend. If you need more information please come and talk to me.
