

How to Control a Cat In Minecraft

Taming a cat in Minecraft is pretty simple, but like other tasks in the game, it isn't written out for you.

Where can I find cats?

There aren't any animal adoption centers in Minecraft. You'll need to find a kitten to take home in the wild. Luckily, cats are easy to find. Stray cats spawn in villages that have at least one villager and four bedrooms. For every four beds in a village, the cat will spawn (up to 10) which means you'll have a variety of colors to pick from in an average village.

Black cats can also be seen around witch huts in swamps.

In the Bedrock Edition of the game (the most popular, modern version of the game that is available on Xbox One, Windows, iOS, Android, and Nintendo Switch), black cats are more likely to spawn when the moon is full.

How do you control a cat?

Step 1 To calm a cat, take some salmon or cod from a nearby river or lake.

Step 2: Equip the raw fish and slowly approach an unattended cat. Minecraft Servers Apply the raw fish to the skeptical kitty.

Step 3: Continue feeding the cat more raw fish until hearts appear above its head, signifying it is being tamed. You will likely have to feed it numerous times to get it to like you, so stock with fish before you attempt this.

Step 4: When the cat has had enough food, the hearts will disappear. The cat will receive a collar. Now you have a pet cat!

Cat behavior

Once you have successfully trained a cat to follow you wherever you go and follow you everywhere. You don't have to lose your cat even if you move 12 blocks away. They are able to teleport to another player if they get lost. Cats that have been trained will not sit still unless they are told to. They will explore the area around the player unless they are instructed to. If you would like an indoor cat to remain with you, for instance, you can tell it to sit.

When they are in a house, cats will climb onto furniture on their own accord. Cats can often be found sitting on the top of beds, furnaces and chests. Like real-life cats, cats in Minecraft are sometimes able to get in your way and make furnaces, chests, etc., unusable until you remove them. If they get involved in something you don't want them messing with you can get them away, lure them away with raw fish, or remove blocks beneath them to force them to move.

A tamed cat could be found near the player when they are asleep at night. When they awake at night, there's a good chance that a pet cat will have something to give you - they could bring strings, raw chicken, a rabbit's foot, and many other items.
