- a. Reasonable substitutes
- 1. The worlds resources seem as good (7:22)
- 2. The worlds alternatives seem sufficient (7:24)
- 3. The word keeps turning (8:15)
- b. Categorical Refusal (8:18-22)

- 1. Refusal to face God's reality (8:18-19)
- 2. Refusal to face God's blessing (8:21-22)
- 3. Refusal to face others' pain (9:11-12)
- c. Irrational resistance (9:27)

Conclusion: Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.
