
What Are The Symptoms of Type 2 Diabetes?

Keeping a healthy weight is an important factor in being able to control the symptoms and causes of type 2 diabetes, and being overweight increases the amount of insulin that is required to maintain normal body glucose levels. The level of insulin required can become too high, and this leads to diabetic complications such as kidney failure and blindness. It is essential to remember that any excess insulin that is not metabolized is stored as fat in the body, and it is this fat that should be eliminated and managed by diet and exercise.

Blurred vision is another symptom of diabetes. As you age, the onset of diabetic complications increases because the number of blood vessels in the eyes becomes progressively damaged. With increasing age, the chance of developing hypertension and heart problems increases as well. Diabetic complications such as blindness and kidney failure are far more common in diabetics.

Dry mouth is another symptom of type 2 diabetes. If you regularly have trouble swallowing

food or if the saliva in your mouth is generally dry, you may be having trouble with the sugar

in the blood. This creates a condition called ketoacidosis, which develops when too much sugar

is not metabolized and excreted from your body.

The symptoms of type 2 diabetes can also include high blood pressure. In this case, the pressure

can be measured with the help of a monitor known as a blood pressure monitor. Hypertension

is a condition where the force of blood against the walls of the arteries increases. High blood

pressure can increase the risk of developing diabetes.
