- Buy indoor fire retardants. If not, pour the fire retardant into the spray bottle.
- Keep children and pets away from the room where your lampshade is.
- Remove the shade from the lamp fixture.
- Place the lamp on a carpeted surface.
- Spray a layer of fire retardant on both sides of the lamp shade. Make sure to cover the entire shadow, but don't soak the shade.
- Wait minutes until the lamp shade dry.
- Return the shade to the lamp fixture.
- Now, children and pets can enter the room.
