Over 100,000 of the Ross rifles and bayonets were purchased from the Canadians. These are clearly marked with UK WD marks to distinguish them from the Canadian models







Many of the other countries during the WW1 or after, such as Belgium, Bulgaria, Finland, Greece, Italy, Serbia, Russia who had been sold or used various French rifles also used these bayonets. After WWI ended the newly created nation of Poland was sold, by the French, many of both type of these bayonets which were used during the Polish-Soviet War (1919-1921) and later during the Polish Invasion of 1939. These bayonets were called Bagnetowy Wzor 1886/93 and were usually marked at the back of the pommel with following markings: Wz86/91 or Wz86/93. Germany also used many of these from captured stocks or from enemy prisoners of war during both World Wars, these bayonets are usually marked with the regimental unit which used them on the side or inside the top groove of the grip, scabard tip is riveted.


Export for Indochina. The main difference between the 1890 and 1902 models was that the 1890 version had a 520mm long cruciform blade and the 1902 bayonet was shortened in 1912 from to 420mm to better accommodate Indochinese. Both of these had a 13mm diameter muzzle ring.




These bayonets were used with the Fusil de Tirailleur Sénégalais Modèle 1907, it was then decided to widen the issuance of the weapon to other colonial troops, except those in Indochina. The bayonets blade were the same length as the Épée-Baïonnette Modèle 1890 (520mm) but the main difference was these did not have the groove that extends down the left side of the bayonet grip.























The only markings found on the bayonets are a small inspection stamp on the blade. Occasionally the bayonets can be found with unit markings on the crossguard. Any blades found with a serial number on the crossguard are Turkish issue.

Huge numbers of the ersatz types were supplied to Turkey at the end of the war (page 192-193):


- a) Unmodified blades with a serial number on the crossguard
- b) Shortened blades the blade is shortened to 250mm with appropriate shortening of the scabbards and replacement of the frog stud by an oval stud one
- c) Modified crossguards initially to fit the bayonets on the export pattern Mauser rifle, subsequently some were further modified to fit the US M1 Garand, these modifications can be quite extensive

Another cathegory of ersatz bayonets is ERSOC (ES) bayonets, where blades from socket bayonets were used. These are rare, recently they have emerged on the market after many depots were discovered in Afganistan, where they were held since the 1920's.







Rare AKM bayonet produced by Turkish Mitas Makina company. Produced since 1977. Its rarity is the result of strict Turkish export laws. The grips are a wood and resin composite, metal parts are parkerised, scabbard is without rubber guard and belt hanger attachment.

TURKISH ERSATZ/CONVERTED

The Turks converted large numbers of bayonets to fit their own weapons, you can find most variations of WWI German made bayonets, Rumanian, Yugoslavian, Czechoslovak and British (also Australian). They also converted their own 1890 and 1903 pattern bayonets. Many were converted to the "1935" pattern to fit a Spanish version of the standard Mauser rifle, these typically have a 250mm blade and crossguard modifications to mount onto this rifle. Some of these blades were also converted to mount onto the US M1 rifle, these typically have a straight sided crossguard.

The ASFA markings found on the hilt of Turkish bayonets is the stamp indicting its manufacture/conversion by the army arsenal that came into existence in 1929, converted blades without the ASFA stamp were converted before this time.


