She has also served as State Secretary of the General Federation of Woman's Club; an international women's organization dedicated to community improvement by enhancing the lives of others through volunteer service. She continually works on promotional and organizational needs of the Poultney club for its many community events. Those include, but are not limited to, "Breakfast with the Easter Bunny", the Christmas season's "Giving Tree" and "Breakfast with Santa" events and the July 4<sup>th</sup> "Petting Zoo". An avid gardener, she often contributes decorative floral arrangements for community events. She has aided with pre-event planning and hands-on help at musical events, church suppers, Welsh heritage events and Poultney's 250<sup>th</sup> celebration planning. Ida Mae said that research and writing of grants for St. John's and United Baptist Church's restoration needs has been, and continues to be, a learning experience, as does also her volunteer time as the primary Editor of St. John's Facebook pages.



Ida Mae has "worked" endlessly as a volunteer on many events, projects and grants for needed repairs for several historic properties in Poultney. Saint John's Episcopal Church and its cemetery as well as historic United Baptist Church are two for which she has devoted endless hours. Each historic property is undergoing needed upgrades. These buildings are part of Poultney's history which everyone feels a connection to, members and non-members alike, who realize the value of them to our community and its identity. Ida Mae has also willingly assisted other community non-profits and ecclesiastical institutions with questions they pose to her regarding grant options they may seek. She writes publicity releases and feature articles about Poultney's current community events, its history and its historic buildings which are published in many periodicals. She has organized a collective history of United Baptist Church, East Poultney. She is a volunteer member of the board of directors of the Horace Greeley Foundation. The Greeley Foundation is a Poultney non-profit which organizes The *Horace Greeley Writers' Symposium*, an annual event in Poultney, Vermont which is a celebration of

Horace Greeley's life. The symposium explores the art of writing as presented by publishers and writers in the fields of literature, poetry, philosophy, and history.

Ida Mae's childhood years were in California; she has been a resident of Poultney since her early teen years. She graduated from Poultney High School and Middlebury College. She returned to the Poultney community after years of work in Vermont and New York locations. She worked in New York City for Time Life; in the President's Office at Williams College and a career as a teacher of English, French and Art in both public and private educational institutions. She has taught children, teens and college students in educational institutions in Adams, Massachusetts, Middle Granville, New York, Vergennes and Poultney, Vermont.

Having begun her life in Poultney as a young teen resident with her parents in historic Eagle Tavern, she has, while continually dedicated to educational studies, career, world-wide travels and volunteer projects, maintained an interest in Poultney's history, writing, art, and its historic buildings. "I could have chosen to live anywhere, but Poultney is where I came back to and where I enjoy being", she explained. She has and continues to share her knowledge, experience and time with the Poultney community.

Living, continually learning and a lifetime of sharing her knowledge for the benefit of the Poultney community, Ida Mae Johnson will be presented Poultney Area Chamber of Commerce's 2018 Citizen of the Year Award.

The Chamber looks forward to the community joining with them for this annual celebration at an Open House reception to be held Sunday, October 21<sup>st</sup> from 2 to 4 p.m. in the Town Room at United Baptist Church, On the Green, East Poultney, Rutland County, Vermont.

The Chamber also invites past recipients of the Citizen of the Year Award to join with them for a 2018 group photograph to be taken of Poultney Citizens of the Year, to-date.

The Chamber's Citizen of the Year Award, presented annually since 1990, honors a resident citizen who has made major contributions to the betterment of Poultney; has distinguished herself or himself through outstanding service to the community and typifies the true spirit of service and self-sacrifice in representing the finest ideals of Poultney citizenship - - a real "unsung hero" of Poultney. As Poultney's 2018 Citizen of the Year, Ida Mae will be the Grand Marshal of the 2019 July 4th parade in Poultney.

Past award recipients are remembered in an historical accounting which may be viewed on the website of Poultney Area Chamber of Commerce. A continually expanding memorabilia scrapbook collection about past citizen award recipients will be available for viewing at the October 21st reception.
